Mr Tan received a supervisory warning from the Monetary Authority of Singapore ("MAS") on 14 July 2014 for a breach of Section 137 of the Securities and Futures Act 2001 (the "Act") for failing to notify a listed corporation of a change in his interest in the voting shares of the corporation, within 2 business days of his becoming aware of the change. This warning was for the disposal by YK Holdings Pte Ltd ("YKH") of shares in LH Group Limited ("LH"), a company listed on the SGX-ST. YKH, a substantial shareholder of LH, disposed of the LH shares on 20 January 2014 and notified LH on 24 January 2014. There was a delay of 2 days in notifying LH. The disposal resulted in YKH ceasing to be a substantial shareholder of LH. As a result of this, YKH and the shareholders of YKH who were deemed interested in the LH shares held by YKH, who amongst others, Mr Tan, who holds 25% shares of YKH, received supervisory warnings from the MAS.
