

Rolls-Royce Appoints SIA Engineering Company as On-Wing Services Provider

SINGAPORE, 16 February 2016 - Mainboard-listed **SIA Engineering Company Limited** (SIAEC) and Rolls-Royce will be signing an agreement today to appoint SIAEC as a Rolls-Royce approved On-Wing Services provider within its Trent Service Network.

With this appointment for the Trent family of engines, including the Trent 1000 and Trent XWB, SIAEC will be supporting an increasing number of Rolls-Royce civil engines fuelled by the growing fleets of new-generation aircraft, such as the Boeing 787 Dreamliner and Airbus A350 XWB. The On-Wing Services programme will offer a range of engine line maintenance support services to Trent engine operators.

SIAEC's Chief Executive Officer, Mr. Png Kim Chiang said: "Leveraging on the combined strengths of SIAEC's international line maintenance network and engine capabilities, and Rolls-Royce's original equipment manufacturer expertise, we are well-positioned to provide airline customers with prompt response and comprehensive technical support for their Trent engines. SIAEC's On-Wing Services support complements the Company's suite of line maintenance services to help customers maximise aircraft availability and reliability."

Eric Schulz, Rolls-Royce, President – Civil Aerospace, said: "We are creating a Trent Service Network that is more capable, competitive and flexible as our engine fleet grows. SIAEC is a valued partner in engine services and today's announcement continues to develop a very successful relationship."

The agreement will not have a material impact on SIAEC's financial performance in FY2015/16. None of the Directors of SIAEC has any interest, direct or indirect, in the transaction.
