ISSUE AND LISTING OF NEW UNITS UNDER THE DISTRIBUTION REINVESTMENT PLAN FOR THE BALANCE 4QFY18/19 DISTRIBUTION

7 June 2019 - Mapletree Industrial Trust Management Ltd., as manager (the “Manager”) of Mapletree Industrial Trust (“MIT”), wishes to announce that it will issue 2,172,035 new units in MIT (“New Units”) at an issue price of S\$2.0193 per unit pursuant to the distribution reinvestment plan (“DRP”) in respect of the distribution of 1.37 Singapore cents per unit in MIT (“Unit”) for the period from 20 February 2019 to 31 March 2019 (“Balance 4QFY18/19 Distribution”) on 7 June 2019.

The New Units will be credited by 10 June 2019 to securities accounts of MIT unitholders (“Unitholders”) who have elected to participate in the DRP. The New Units will commence trading on the Main Board of Singapore Exchange Securities Trading Limited (“SGX-ST”) at 9.00 a.m. on 10 June 2019.

The new Units will rank pari passu in all respects with the existing Units.

Following the issuance of the New Units, the total number of MIT Units in issue has increased from 2,021,418,096 to 2,023,590,131.

Unitholders who did not elect or partially elected to participate in the DRP and overseas Unitholders who did not provide registered addresses in Singapore to The Central Depository (Pte) Limited, will receive their respective entitlements to the Balance 4QFY18/19 Distribution in cash on 10 June 2019.
