ANNOUNCEMENT ON THE PROGRESS OF PROJECTS FOR THE FIRST HALF OF 2026

This announcement is issued by SIIC ENVIRONMENT HOLDINGS LTD. (the “**Company**”, together with its subsidiaries, the “**Group**”) on a voluntary basis. As a water treatment and environmental protection company listed on the Main Board of the Singapore Exchange Securities Trading Limited and the Main Board of The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited, the Company wishes to provide its shareholders and potential investors with an update on the Group’s latest business developments.

The Group is pleased to announce that in the first half of 2026, it continued to deepen its presence in its core business segments, including wastewater treatment, water supply and reclaimed water, achieving multiple key milestones, including the completion of acquisition projects, commencement of new operation and maintenance (“**O&M**”) projects, and commissioning of upgrading and expansion projects. The details are as follows:

- Completion of acquisitions projects: Four projects were successfully completed, comprising two projects in Dalian, Liaoning Province (with a combined capacity of 60,000 tonnes per day) and two projects in Anshan City, Liaoning Province (with a combined capacity of 230,000 tonnes per day).
- New O&M operation projects: One industrial wastewater treatment project in Shanghai

commenced operations (12,000 tonnes per day); one ecological industrial park wastewater treatment project in Zhejiang Province was successfully awarded (70,000 tonnes per day); and one upgrading and expansion project in Fujian Province increased its designed capacity from 25,000 tonnes per day to 32,500 tonnes per day.

- Upgrading and expansion projects: One wastewater treatment plant expansion project in Shandong Province was successfully commissioned (30,000 tonnes per day), and two upgrading projects in Jiangsu Province commenced operations (with a combined capacity of 45,000 tonnes per day).

The above projects further strengthen the Group's market presence and operational scale, reflecting the Group's continued efforts and achievements in wastewater treatment and water supply and reinforcing its position as a key industry leader in China's water and environmental services sector.

An overview of the relevant projects is as follows:-

1. Completion of Acquisition Projects

- **Anshan Ningyuan Wastewater Treatment Plant Project**

The project completed the industrial and commercial registration change in June 2026. The project has a designed treatment capacity of 80,000 tonnes per day. The effluent complies with Grade 1A requirements under the *China's Discharge Standard of Pollutants for Municipal Wastewater Treatment Plants* (GB18918-2002).

- **Anshan Dongtai Wastewater Treatment Plant Project**

The project completed the industrial and commercial registration change in June 2026. The project has a designed treatment capacity of 150,000 tonnes per day. The effluent complies with Grade 1A requirements under the *China's Discharge Standard of Pollutants for Municipal Wastewater Treatment Plants* (GB18918-2002).

- **Dalian Lüshun Economic Development Zone Wastewater Treatment Plant Project**

The project completed the industrial and commercial registration change in July 2026. The project has a designed treatment capacity of 30,000 tonnes per day. The effluent complies with Grade 1A requirements under the *China's Discharge Standard of Pollutants for Municipal Wastewater Treatment Plants* (GB18918-2002).

- **Lüshun Economic Development Zone Reclaimed Water Pipeline Construction Project**
The project completed the industrial and commercial registration change in July 2026. The project has a designed reclaimed water supply capacity of 30,000 tonnes per day, with reclaimed water supplied for industrial production and landscaping irrigation.

2. O&M Operation Projects

- **Shanghai Hangzhou Bay Economic and Technological Development Zone Industrial Wastewater Treatment Plant O&M Project**
The project commenced operations in January 2026. It has a designed treatment capacity of 12,000 tonnes per day. The effluent complies with Grade 1A requirements under the *China's Discharge Standard of Pollutants for Municipal Wastewater Treatment Plants* (GB18918-2002). The O&M contract period is three years.
- **Sino-Italy Ningbo Eco-Park Wastewater Treatment Plant Project**
The project was awarded in March 2026. It has a designed treatment capacity of 70,000 tonnes per day. The effluent complies with Grade 1A requirements under the *China's Discharge Standard of Pollutants for Municipal Wastewater Treatment Plants* (GB18918-2002). The O&M contract period is three years.
- **Longmen Town Wastewater Treatment Plant Upgrading and Expansion O&M Project, Anxi County, Quanzhou**
A supplemental agreement was signed in May 2026, increasing the project's designed capacity from 25,000 tonnes per day to 32,500 tonnes per day. The effluent complies with Grade 1A requirements under the *China's Discharge Standard of Pollutants for Municipal Wastewater Treatment Plants* (GB18918-2002). The O&M contract period is fifteenth years.

3. Upgrading and Expansion Projects

- **Shanting District Wastewater Treatment Plant Upgrading and Expansion Project, Zaozhuang City**
The upgrading works were completed and the project commenced operations in January 2026. It has a designed treatment capacity of 30,000 tonnes per day. The effluent complies with the Quasi-Class IV Standard under the *Environmental Quality Standards for Surface Water* (GB3838-2002).

- **Phase I Upgrading Project of Xingang Industrial Park Wastewater Treatment Plant, Jingjiang City**

The upgrading works were completed and the project commenced operations in March 2026. It has a designed treatment capacity of 20,000 tonnes per day. The effluent complies with Level C under the *Discharge Standard of Major Water Pollutants for Municipal Wastewater Treatment Plants* (DB32/4440-2022).

- **Phase I Upgrading Project of Huangqiao Wastewater Treatment Plant, Taixing City**

The upgrading works were completed and the project commenced operations in March 2026. It has a designed treatment capacity of 25,000 tonnes per day. The effluent complies with Level C under the *Discharge Standard of Major Water Pollutants for Municipal Wastewater Treatment Plants* (DB32/4440-2022).
