



CNMC Produced Another Record in Single Gold Pour of 2,945.01 Ounces of Gold Doré Bars¹

All capitalised terms used in this announcement shall, unless otherwise defined herein, have the meaning ascribed to them in the Company's announcement dated 28 February 2014 in relation to the record single gold pour ("Announcement").

The board of directors (the "Board") of CNMC Goldmine Holdings Limited ("CNMC" or the "Company") is delighted to report that the Company's Sokor Gold Project has produced another record for a single gold pour of 2,945.01 ounces of gold doré bars¹.

This represents the highest production output on record for a single gold pour since the start of the Company's gold production in July 2010. As compared to the previous record of 2,314.42 ounces as reported in the Announcement, this reflects an increase of approximately 27.2%.
