
PROFIT WARNING ON UNAUDITED FINANCIAL RESULTS FOR THE HALF YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2025

The Board of Directors (the “**Board**”) of Pasture Holdings Limited (the “**Company**”, and together with its subsidiaries, the “**Group**”) wishes to inform shareholders of the Company that the Group expects to report a net loss for the six-month period ended 31 December 2025 (“**1H2026**”).

Based on the preliminary review of the Group’s draft unaudited consolidated financial results for 1H2026, the expected net loss is mainly attributable to lower revenue and lower gross profit margin generated from pharmaceutical wholesale and distribution segment as compared to the corresponding six-month period ended 31 December 2024 (“**1H2025**”). The lower revenue and gross profit margin were mainly due to supply-chain disruptions across key markets and costs incurred by higher compliance requirements for cross-border pharmaceutical shipments compared to 1H2025.

The Company is currently finalising the condensed interim financial statements of the Group for the reporting period, scheduled for release on or before 13 February 2026.

The disruptions to the supply chain, heightened compliance requirements and ongoing geopolitical uncertainty are expected to persist into the second half and may materially affect the Group’s performance for the financial year ending 30 June 2026.
