The first cohorts for all courses are only scheduled to begin in its Singapore campus after due diligence and validation of Informatics Academy by USW and upon obtaining the necessary permissions from the relevant regulatory bodies. As at the date of press release, these courses have not been submitted for registration nor has permission been granted for offering these courses. Plans are also afoot to offers these courses at other regional offices and to expand this collaboration to other courses.
