Basslink receives a letter from the State of Tasmania to refer dispute to arbitration

Basslink Pty Ltd (Basslink) has today received a letter from the State of Tasmania (State), in relation to claims made recently by the State (refer to Basslink media statements issued 22 and 26 March 2018), to refer the dispute to arbitration. Basslink maintains its position that there is no proper basis for these claims.

While reserving its rights in this matter, in good faith, Basslink recently attended "without prejudice" meetings with the representatives of the State in an attempt to resolve the dispute in accordance with the Basslink Operations Agreement. Unfortunately, the dispute was not resolved, and has led to Basslink being notified by the State today that the dispute is referred to arbitration.

Basslink intends to vigorously defend itself in the arbitration and continues to reserve all its rights in this matter.
