Structural steel specialist secures new contracts bringing total order book to \$170 million

SINGAPORE – 24 November 2017 – T T J Holdings Limited (“T T J” or together with its subsidiaries, the “Group”) today announced it has secured a series of new contracts, boosting its latest total order book from \$152 million recorded on 25 September 2017 to \$170 million today.

The contracts secured involve the supply, fabrication and installation of structural steelworks to various projects. They comprise steelworks for an integrated construction and prefabrication hub, a second contract for Phase 2 of a building project at Jurong West, which is a follow-up contract from Phase 1 secured in 2015 from the same client, as well as additional orders under the Mandai Depot project.

T T J’s Chairman and Managing Director, Mr Teo Hock Chwee (张福水) said, “We are very encouraged by this set of contract wins as they include additional orders from an existing client, which is a testament to the quality of work the Group delivers and the trust our clients place in T T J. We aim to be a reliable partner in the projects we work on and will continue to build on our reputation as a preferred structural steelworks provider in the market. Looking ahead, ample opportunities, especially from public infrastructure construction, continue to exist in the market and we hope to sustain this momentum in our order book building.”
