(1) Inventories recognised as an expense in cost of sales

Inventories recognised as an expense decreased by \$100k from \$827k in Q1 FY2016 to \$727k in Q1 FY2017.

The decrease was due mainly to reduction of sales of goods.

(2) Utilities

Utilities expenses decreased by \$142k from \$381k in Q1 FY2016 to \$239k in Q1 FY2017.

The decrease was due mainly to reduction of electricity rates.

(3) Other expenses

Other expenses decreased by \$270k from \$754k in Q1 FY2016 to \$484k in Q1 FY2017.

The decrease was due to a realisation of translation loss on disposal of a subsidary that occurred in Q1 FY2016, reduction of franchise fee and professional fees.

(4) Income tax expenses

Income tax expenses decreased by \$106k from \$246k in Q1 FY2016 to \$140k in Q1 FY2017.

The decrease was due mainly to more tax incentives enjoyed by a subsidary.

(5) Statement of financial position

As at 31 March 2017, the Group's net assets attributable to the Company's shareholders were \$55.02m as compared to \$54.22m as at 31 December 2016. The net assets of \$55.02m included cash and cash equivalents of \$42.04m. The net assets as at 31 December 2016 of \$54.22m included cash and cash equivalents of \$41.27m.

Prepayments decreased by \$185k from \$416k at the end of FY2016 to \$231k at the end of Q1 2017. The decrease was due mainly to a prepayment for club software made at the end of FY2016 which was capitalised to property plant and equipment in January 2017.

(7) Trade and other payables

Trade and other payables increased by \$698k from \$3.47m at the end of FY2016 to \$4.16m at the end of Q1 FY2017. The increase was due mainly to tigher management of trade payables.

(8) Other Liabilities

Other Liabilities decreased by \$717k from \$2.45m at the end of FY2016 to \$1.74m at the end of Q1 FY2017. The decrease was due mainly to variable bonus accrued in FY2016 that were paid in Q1 FY2017.
