

UPDATE ON RESTRICTED MOVEMENT CONTROL ORDER IMPLEMENTED BY THE GOVERNMENT OF MALAYSIA

The Board of Directors (the “**Board**”) of LHT Holdings Ltd (the “**Company**”) and together with its subsidiaries, (the “**Group**”) wishes to inform shareholders (“**Shareholders**”) that due to the Covid-19 outbreak situation in Malaysia, the Malaysian Government has, on 16 March 2020, announced a 14-day Restricted Movement Control Order (“**RMO**”), where all Malaysians are prohibited from leaving Malaysia, and all businesses are to be closed except for those involved in certain essential goods and services, commencing on 18 March 2020.

The Group’s manufacturing facilities in Malaysia are subject to this RMO and are temporarily closed in compliance with the RMO directive. During this time, the Group is working closely with the Malaysian authorities to obtain clearance for the resumption of operations.

In regards to the Company’s Malaysian-based employees who make daily commutes to work in the Company in Singapore, the Company has already arranged accommodation in Singapore for those who agree to remain in Singapore during the period of the RMO.

During this difficult period, the Company’s priority is the safety, health and wellbeing of its employees while at the same time ensuring the long term sustainability of its operations.
