APPENDIX A

Steps for registration, submission of questions and voting at the AGM

Shareholders (including CPF and SRS investors) can attend the AGM in person, submit questions to the Chairman of the Meeting in advance of, or at, the AGM and/or vote at the AGM by themselves or through duly appointed proxy(ies).

To do so, they will need to complete the following steps:

1.	Register in person to attend the AGM	Shareholders, including CPF and SRS investors, and (where applicable) their duly appointed proxies can attend the AGM in person.
		To do so, they or their proxies will need to register in person at the registration counter(s) outside the AGM venue on the day of the event. Registration will commence at 10.00 a.m. on that day. Please bring along your NRIC/passport to enable the Company to verify your identity.
		Shareholders are advised not to attend the AGM if they are feeling unwell.
2.	Submit questions in advance of, or at, the AGM	Shareholders, including CPF and SRS investors, can submit questions in advance of, or at, the AGM.
		Submission of substantial and relevant questions in advance of the AGM. Shareholders, including CPF and SRS investors, can submit substantial and relevant questions related to the resolutions to be tabled for approval at the AGM to the Chairman of the Meeting, in advance of the AGM, in the following manner:
		 (a) Via email to corp@ren-united.com (b) By post to the Company's registered address at 16 Kallang Place, #05-10/18, Kallang Basin Industrial Estate, Singapore 339156.
		Shareholders who submit questions via email or by post must provide the Company with the following details:
		 the shareholder's full name; the shareholder's address; and the manner in which the shareholder holds shares in the Company (e.g., via CDP, CPF/SRS and/or scrip).
		Shareholders, including CPF and SRS investors, may submit questions in advance of the AGM, beginning from the date after the publication of the Notice of AGM.
		All questions submitted in advance of the AGM via any of the above channels must be received by 11.30 a.m. on 23 September 2023, i.e., 72 hours prior to the commencement period for the submission of instruments appointing a proxy(ies). This is to provide the Company with sufficient time to publish its response to questions submitted in advance of the AGM.
		Asking substantial and relevant questions at the AGM. Shareholders, including CPF and SRS investors, and (where applicable) duly appointed proxies can also ask the Chairman of the

Meeting substantial and relevant questions related to the resolutions to be tabled for approval at the AGM, at the AGM itself.

Addressing questions. The Company will address all substantial and relevant questions received from shareholders by the submission deadline of 23 September 2023 by publishing its responses to such questions on the Company's corporate website at the URL https://www.ren-united.com and the SGX website between 48 to 72 hours prior to the deadline for the submission of instruments appointing a proxy(ies).

The Company will address any subsequent clarifications sought, or substantial and relevant follow-up questions (which are related to the resolutions to be tabled for approval at the AGM) received after the submission deadline 23 September 2023 which have not already been addressed prior to the AGM, as well as those substantial and relevant questions received at the AGM, at the AGM itself. Where substantially similar questions are received, the Company will consolidate such questions and consequently not all questions may be individually addressed.

Minutes of AGM. The Company will publish the minutes of the AGM on the Company's website and the SGX website within 30 days from the date of the AGM, and the minutes will include the responses to substantial and relevant questions from shareholders which are addressed during the AGM.

3. Vote, or submit instruments appointing a proxy(ies) to vote, at the AGM

Shareholders can vote at the AGM themselves or through duly appointed proxy(ies). Shareholders who wish to appoint a proxy(ies) must submit an instrument appointing a proxy(ies).

Submission of instruments appointing a proxy(ies). The instrument appointing a proxy(ies) must be submitted to the Company in the following manner:

- (a) if submitted by post, be lodged with the Company's Share Registrar, Tricor Barbinder Share Registration Services at 80 Robinson Road, #11-02, Singapore 068898; or
- (b) if submitted electronically, be submitted via email to corp@ren-united.com,

in any case no later than seventy-two (72) hours before the time set for the AGM, i.e., by 11.30 a.m. on 26 September 2023.

A shareholder who wishes to submit an instrument appointing a proxy(ies) by post or via email can either use the printed copy of the proxy form which is sent to him/her/it by post or download a copy of the proxy form from the Company's website or the SGX website, and complete and sign the proxy form, before submitting it by post to the address provided above, or before scanning and sending it by email to the email address provided above.

Deemed revocation of proxy appointment if shareholder attends the AGM in person.

Completion and submission of the instrument appointing a proxy(ies) by a shareholder will not prevent him/her from attending, speaking and voting at the AGM if he/she so wishes. The appointment of the proxy(ies) for the AGM will be deemed to be revoked if the

shareholder attends the AGM in person and in such event, the Company reserves the right to refuse to admit any person or persons appointed under the relevant instrument appointing a proxy(ies) to the AGM.

CPF and SRS investors. CPF and SRS investors:

- (a) may vote at the AGM if they are appointed as proxies by their respective CPF Agent Banks or SRS Operators, and should contact their respective CPF Agent Banks or SRS Operators if they have any queries regarding their appointment as proxies; or
- (b) may appoint the Chairman of the Meeting as proxy to vote on their behalf at the AGM, in which case they should approach their respective CPF Agent Banks or SRS Operators to submit their votes by 11.30 a.m. on 22 September 2023, i.e., 7 days before the date of the AGM.
