(a) Review of income statement of the group

Revenue

The revenue of the Group for Q1 2006 of RMB 8.6 million and for Q1 2005:of RMB 12.0 million were derived from:

Our sales of properties of RMB 6.5 million in Q1 2006 were attributed mainly to additional sales for units in Sunlight City — Yi Yuan, which were completed in FY2005. For Q1 2005, our sales of properties of RMB 9.4 million were attributed mainly to additional sales for units in Sunlight City — Jing Yuan, which were completed in FY2004.

Gross Profit

In line with the completion method (instead of percentage of completion) of revenue recognition as advocated by IFRS, the Group recorded a gross profit of RMB 7.2 million for Q1 2006 as compared to RMB 5.6 million for Q1 2005. The higher gross profit in Q1 2006 was mainly attributed to sales of commercial properties at Sunlight City — Yi Yuan, which command higher profit margin.

Traditionally, because of the spring festive period, the gross profit of the first quarter of each calendar year of the Group is generally low.

Operating Profit

As a result of the improved gross profit, our operating profit increased markedly by 47% from RMB 3.0 million in Q1 2005 to RMB 4.4 million in Q1 2006.

Finance Cost

In Q1 2005, finance cost of RMB 0.02 million were expensed off. In contrast, no finance costs were recognised in Q1 2006 in the Group's profit and loss statement as these were capitalised as part of our development costs.

IPO Expenses

IPO expenses represent expenses incurred in relation to the Company's IPO on the Singapore Exchange. The amount expensed was computed in accordance with IFRS. Had the Company adopted Singapore Financial Reporting Standards and applied Singapore Statement of Recommended Accounting Practice 9 "IPO Costs", some of amount expensed to profit and loss statement may be capitalised as a deduction against equity for the period ended 31 March 2006.

Net Profit

Had it not for the one-time charged of IPO expenses of RMB 3.0 million, the Group's net profit after tax would have nearly doubled from RMB 2.1 million for Q1 2005 to RMB 4.0 million for Q1 2006.

(b) Review of balance sheet of the Group

Non-current Assets

Our non-current assets increased by RMB 0.9 million from RMB 253.7 million as at 31 December 2005 to RMB 254.6 million as at 31 March 2006 due mainly to the addition of fixed assets net of depreciation expenses.

Current Assets

Our current assets increased by RMB 208.5 million from RMB 617.2 million as at 31 December 2005 to RMB 825.7 million as at 31 March 2006. The increase was mainly attributed to the net IPO proceeds of RMB 265.1 million.

Current Liabilities

Our current liabilities decreased by RMB 59.8 million from RMB 429.2 million as at 31 December 2005 to RMB 369.4 million as at 31 March 2006 due mainly to settlement of trade payables.

Cash and Working Capital Positions

As a result of the net IPO proceeds of RMB 265.1 million, the cash and working capital positions of the Group ballooned from RMB 18.1 million and RMB 188.1 million respectively as at 31 December 2005 to RMB 307.7 million and RMB 456.3 million respectively as at 31 March 2006.

The Group is well placed to recognise revenue and profit from the developments to be completed by this financial year now classified as "Properties under development for sale" in the balance sheet.

Given the development pipe line, the stage of completion and the contracted purchases for our properties, barring unforeseen circumstances, we are optimistic about the full year profitability of the Group for FY2006.
