### 28<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING OF SINGAPORE TELECOMMUNICATIONS LIMITED

- **1. Background.** Singapore Telecommunications Limited ("**Singtel**") refers to the following:

  - (b) the COVID-19 (Temporary Measures) Act 2020 which enables the Minister for Law by order to prescribe alternative arrangements for listed companies in Singapore to, *inter alia*, conduct general meetings, either wholly or partly, by electronic communication, video conferencing, tele-conferencing or other electronic means;
  - (c) the COVID-19 (Temporary Measures) (Alternative Arrangements for Meetings for Companies, Variable Capital Companies, Business Trusts, Unit Trusts and Debenture Holders) Order 2020 (the "**Order**") which sets out the alternative arrangements in respect of, *inter alia*, general meetings of companies; and
  - (d) the joint statement released by the Accounting and Corporate Regulatory Authority, the Monetary Authority of Singapore and SGX RegCo on 13 April 2020 (and subsequently updated on 27 April 2020 and 22 June 2020) which provides additional guidance on the conduct of general meetings during the period from 27 March 2020 to 30 September 2020.
  - 2. Date, time and conduct of Annual General Meeting. Singtel is pleased to announce that pursuant to the Order, the 28<sup>th</sup> Annual General Meeting of Singtel ("AGM") will be convened and held by way of electronic means on <u>Thursday, 30 July 2020 at 10.00 a.m. (Singapore time)</u>. Singtel's Chairman, Mr Simon Israel, will conduct the proceedings of the AGM.
  - 3. Notice of AGM, Letter to Shareholders, Proxy Form and Voting Instruction Form for SDS Investors. The Notice of AGM, the Letter to Shareholders dated 1 July 2020 (in relation to the proposed renewal of the share purchase mandate and the proposed alterations to Singtel's constitution), the Proxy Form and the Voting Instruction Form for SDS Investors will be sent to shareholders solely by electronic means via publication on Singtel's corporate website at <a href="https://www.singtel.com/about-us/investor-relations/annual-reports">https://www.singtel.com/about-us/investor-relations/annual-reports</a> and on the SGX website at <a href="https://www.sigx.com/securities/company-announcements">https://www.sigx.com/securities/company-announcements</a>.

- 4. No personal attendance at the AGM. Due to the current COVID-19 situation in Singapore, shareholders will not be able to attend the AGM in person.
- 5. Alternative arrangements for participation in the AGM. Shareholders may participate in the AGM by:
  - (a) observing and/or listening to the AGM proceedings via live audio-visual webcast or live audio-only stream;

- (b) submitting questions in advance of the AGM; and/or
- (c) appointing the Chairman of the AGM ("**Chairman**") as proxy to attend, speak and vote on their behalf at the AGM.

Details of the steps for pre-registration, pre-submission of questions and voting at the AGM are set out in the **Appendix** to this announcement.

# 6. Investors who hold Singtel shares through relevant intermediaries (as defined in Section 181 of the Companies Act (Chapter 50 of Singapore).

SDS investors who wish to request the CPF Board to appoint the Chairman as its proxy to attend, speak and vote at the AGM in respect of the Singtel shares held by the CPF Board on their behalf should submit their Voting Instruction Form for SDS Investors to Singtel by **5.00 p.m. on 20 July 2020**.

- (b) Investors holding Singtel shares through relevant intermediaries (otherwise than under CPFIS, SRS or SDS Scheme) who wish to participate in the AGM by:
  - observing and/or listening to the AGM proceedings via live audio-visual webcast or live audio-only stream;
  - (ii) submitting questions in advance of the AGM; and/or
  - (iii) requesting their relevant intermediaries to appoint the Chairman as their proxy to attend, speak and vote at the AGM in respect of the Singtel shares held by such relevant intermediaries on their behalf,
