Financial performance (1Q2016 vs. 1Q2015)

Revenue increased by US\$9.9 million from US\$2.9 million in 1Q2015 to US\$12.8 million in 1Q2016 mainly due to higher revenue contribution from coal sales following the commencement of SDJ mine operation production in December 2015, offset by lower revenue from mining services.

We incurred a gross loss in 1Q2016 as we continue to experience soft coal prices and our profitability is further affected by non-cash depreciation and amortisation of deferred stripping costs amounting to US\$1.8 million and US\$0.2 million, respectively. Excluding these non-cash costs, our cash gross profit stands at US\$1.9 million, out of which US\$1.5 million is attributable to SDJ mine operation.

Other income decreased by US\$0.6 million, from US\$1.6 million in 1Q2015 to US\$1.0 million in 1Q2016, mainly due to reduction in forex gain by US\$1.4 million, offset by increase in interest income of US\$0.4 million and forfeited a deposit from a customer of US\$0.3 million.

General and administrative expenses decreased by US\$0.5 million, from US\$2.0 million in 1Q2015 to US\$1.5 million in 1Q2016, mainly due to cost cutting measures.

Other expenses remained at US\$0.2 million.

Finance costs decreased by US\$0.2 million, from US\$2.0 million in 1Q2015 to US\$1.8 million in 1Q2016, mainly due to lower amortised borrowing costs pertaining to the notes payable.

Depreciation increased by US\$0.8 million, from US\$1.2 million in 1Q2015 to US\$2.0 million in 1Q2016, mainly due to depreciation of SDJ mining property, which commenced operation only in December 2015.

Income tax credit decreased by US\$0.8 million, from US\$0.9 million in 1Q2015 to US\$0.1 million in 1Q2016, mainly as a result of decreased tax benefits recognised in 1Q2016 as compared to 1Q2015, in tandem with decreased tax losses and increased non-tax deductible expenses from the Group, mainly attributing to the amortisation of acquisition cost of SDJ during the current financial period.

Overall, the Group's net loss decreased by US\$0.1 million, from US\$2.7 million in 1Q2015 to US\$2.6 million in 1Q2016.

Cash Flow (1Q2016 vs. 1Q2015)

The Group recorded a net decrease in cash and cash equivalents of US\$4.8 million in 1Q2016 compared to a decrease of US\$1.0 million in 1Q2015, which was mainly due to interest and finance lease payments, and an increase in deferred stripping costs.

Net cash from operating activities in 1Q2016 was US\$2.0 million. Operating cash flows before movements in working capital was an inflow of US\$1.1 million, with further cash inflows of US\$0.9 million from our working capital movements.

Net cash used in investing activities in 1Q2016 of US\$3.0 million was mainly due to increase in deferred stripping costs of US\$2.9 million and purchase of property, plant and equipment of US\$0.1 million.

Net cash used in financing activities in 1Q2016 of US\$3.8 million was due to interest payment of US\$2.9 million, and repayment of finance leases of US\$0.9 million.

Financial Position - Group

Current assets increased by US\$2.2 million, from US\$69.0 million as at 31 December 2015 to US\$71.2 million as at 31 March 2016, mainly due to increases in (i) asset held for sale of US\$3.0 million, being reclassification from investment properties after the exercise of Option to Purchase ("OTP") with a third party purchaser; (ii) trade and other receivables of US\$2.8 million, due mainly to timing difference on letter of credits payment from customers on coal sales at the end of the quarter; (iii) deposits and prepayments of US\$0.7 million; and (iv) inventory of US\$0.3 million. These were offset by the decrease in cash and bank balances by US\$4.6 million.

Non-current assets decreased by US\$0.8 million, from US\$146.1 million as at 31 December 2015 to US\$145.3 million as at 31 March 2016, mainly due to the aforementioned decreases in investment properties by US\$2.8 million; and property, plant and equipment of US\$1.0 million. These were offset by increases in deferred stripping costs of US\$2.7 million and deferred tax assets of US\$0.2 million.

Current liabilities decreased from US\$46.2 million as at 31 December 2015 to US\$45.4 million as at 31 March 2016, mainly due to reduction in unpaid purchase consideration for the acquisition of SDJ mining concession in FY2015, by way of issuance of new shares in the Company of US\$3.5 million; and repayment of finance leases of US\$0.3 million. These were partially offset by increase in trade and other payables, other than the aforementioned purchase consideration, of US\$3.0 million.

Non-current liabilities increased by US\$3.4 million, from US\$75.0 million as at 31 December 2015 to US\$78.4 million as at 31 March 2016, mainly due to increases in notes payable resulting from stronger SGD against USD, deferred tax liabilities and provisions; partially offset by a reduction of finance leases during the period.

Financial Position - Company

Current assets decreased by US\$29.3 million, from US\$67.1 million as at 31 December 2015 to US\$37.8 million as at 31 March 2016, mainly due to decrease in cash and bank balances of US\$4.4 million and reclassification of intercompany receivables, amounting to approximately US\$29.7 million, as deemed investment in subsidiaries. The overall decrease is partially offset by increases in (i) asset held for sale of US\$3.0 million, being reclassification from investment properties after the exercise of OTP by purchaser; and (ii) trade and other receivables of US\$1.8 million.

Non-current assets increased by US\$26.6 million, from US\$101.0 million as at 31 December 2015 to US\$127.6 million as at 31 March 2016, mainly due to the abovementioned reclassification of intercompany receivables as deemed investment in subsidiaries and increases in deferred tax assets of US\$0.1 million. The overall increase is partially offset by decrease in investment properties of US\$2.8 million as a result of reclassification to asset held for sale after the exercise of OTP.

Current liabilities decreased by US\$5.4 million, from US\$22.1 million as at 31 December 2015 to US\$16.7 million as at 31 March 2016, mainly due to lower non-trade intercompany payables and reduction in unpaid purchase consideration for the acquisition of SDJ mining concession in FY2015, by way of issuance of share capital to its former owner.

Non-current liabilities increased by US\$3.6 million, from US\$69.4 million as at 31 December 2015 to US\$73.0 million as at 31 March 2016, mainly due to increase in notes payable denominated in SGD, resulting from stronger SGD against USD.

There is no material deviation in the actual results for the first quarter ended 31 March 2016 from what was previously discussed under paragraph 10 of the Company's financial statements for the fourth quarter ended 31 December 2015.

10. A commentary at the date of the announcement of the significant trends and competitive conditions of the industry in which the group operates and any known factors or events that may affect the group in the next reporting period and the next 12 months

The Indonesian coal mining industry continues to face pressure from an expansionary supply situation and weak demand, resulting in a general expectation of coal prices to remain relatively soft in the near future. The Indonesian Coal Reference Price (HBA) has decreased during the last three months from US\$53.51 in December 2015 to US\$51.62 in March 2016⁽¹⁾.

On 29 February 2016 and 4 March 2016, the Group entered into separate conditional sale and purchase agreements with (i) Sunrise Wealth Success Limited for the acquisition of 100% shareholding interest in Borneo Bara Resources Pte Ltd, and (ii) Alliance Joy Ltd for the acquisition of 100% shareholding interest in Blessing Capital Pte Ltd. These acquisitions will allow the Group to access and exercise control over the mining concession and the coal deposits located in the mining permit area. This in turn would increase the Group's reserves of high-calorific-value coal available for production. Please refer to the relevant announcements for further information.

SDJ has commenced commercial production of its coal mine asset in December 2015 and the first shipment of 55,000 tonnes was delivered in January 2016. The Group is targeting to produce more than 6 million tonnes of coal a year. As at 31 March 2016, SDJ has delivered 485,000 tonnes in total to customers in the region.
