

PARTICIPATION IN SPECIAL GENERAL MEETING

1. Background

The Trendlines Group Ltd. (the "Company") refers to the Company's Notice of Special General Meeting ("SGM") dated 16 March 2021.

2. Date, Time and Conduct of the SGM

The Company is pleased to announce that its SGM will be convened and held by way of electronic means on **Thursday**, **22 April 2021 at 1:30 p.m.** (Singapore time) (or immediately after the conclusion or adjournment of the Annual General Meeting of the Company to be held at 1:00 p.m. (Singapore time) on the same day by virtual-only meeting format) pursuant to the Covid-19 (Temporary Measures) (Alternative Arrangements for Meetings for Companies, Variable Capital Companies, Business Trusts, Unit Trusts and Debenture Holders) Order 2020.

3. Circular to Shareholders

4. Questions

Members will <u>not</u> be able to ask questions during the live audio-visual webcast or live audio-only stream of the SGM, and therefore it is important for members submit their questions (if any) no later than seven (7) working days in advance of the SGM by 1.30 p.m. on Tuesday, 13 April 2021 in the following manner:

- (a) if submitted by post, be deposited at the Company's Singapore Share Registrar and Share Transfer Office, Boardroom Corporate & Advisory Services Pte. Ltd, at 50 Raffles Place, #32-01 Singapore Land Tower, Singapore 048623; or
- (b) if submitted electronically, be submitted via email to haim@trendlines.com.

5. No Personal Attendance at the SGM

In light of the current Covid-19 measures in Singapore and the Company's effort to minimise physical interactions and risk of community spread of Covid-19, a member will **not** be able to attend the SGM in person.

6. Alternative Arrangements for the Participation at the SGM

Members may participate at the SGM by:

(a) observing and/or listening to the SGM proceedings via live audio-visual webcast or live audio-only stream;

- (b) submitting questions (if any) in advance of the SGM; and/or
- (c) appointing the Chairman of the Meeting as proxy to attend, speak and vote on the members' behalf at the SGM.

Details of the steps and deadlines for pre-registration, submission of questions in advance and voting at the SGM are set out in Paragraph 8 below and the Appendix to this announcement.

7. Persons Who Hold Shares Through Relevant Intermediaries

Persons who hold shares of the Company through relevant intermediaries (as defined in Section 181 of the Companies Act, Chapter 50 of Singapore), including Central Provident Fund ("CPF") or Supplementary Retirement Scheme ("SRS") investors, and who wish to participate in the SGM by (a) observing and/or listening to the SGM proceedings via live audio-visual webcast or live audio-only stream; (b) submitting questions (if any) in advance of the SGM; and/or (c) appointing the Chairman of the Meeting as proxy to attend, speak and vote on their behalf at the SGM, should contact the relevant intermediary (which would include, in the case of CPF and SRS investors, their respective CPF Agent Banks and SRS Operators) through which they hold such shares as soon as possible and in any case, by 1.30 p.m. on Tuesday, 13 April 2021 in order for the necessary arrangements to be made for their participation in the SGM.

APPENDIX

Steps for Pre-Registration, Submission of Questions in Advance, and Voting at the SGM

Members will be able to observe the SGM proceedings through a live audio-visual webcast via mobile phones, tablets or computers or listen to these proceedings through a live audio-only stream via telephone, submit questions (if any) in advance of the SGM and voting by appointing the Chairman of the Meeting as proxy to attend, speak and vote on his/her/their behalf at the SGM.

To do so, members will need to complete the following steps:

Pre-Registration	Members <u>must</u> pre-register by submitting an email to shira@trendlines.com (the "Registration Email") containing: (i) name in full; (ii) NRIC/Passport/Company Registration number; and (iii) Registered Address from 16 March 2021, Tuesday till 1.30 p.m. by 19 April 2021, Monday (the "Registration Deadline") to enable the Company to verify his/her/their status as members. Members are encouraged to pre-register early from 16 March 2021, Tuesday. Following the verification, authenticated members will receive an email on 21 April 2021, Wednesday (the "Confirmation Email"). Submission of Questions (if any) in Advance	Members will <u>not</u> be able to ask questions during the live audio-visual webcast or live audio-only stream of the SGM, and therefore it is important for members to pre-register and submit their questions (if any) in advance of the SGM.
	If members have any questions in relation to any resolution tabled for approval at the SGM, members <u>must submit</u> the questions (if any) no later than seven (7) working days in advance of the SGM by 1.30 p.m. on Tuesday, 13 April 2021 in the following manner:

Persons who hold shares of the Company through relevant intermediaries (as defined in Section 181 of the Companies Act, Chapter 50 of Singapore), including CPF or SRS investors who wish to submit questions should approach their respective CPF Agent Banks or SRS Operators by **1.30 p.m. on 13 April 2021, Tuesday**.

Submission of Proxy Form

Appointment of Chairman of the Meeting as Proxy

A member (whether individual or corporate) who pre-register to observe and/or listen to the SGM proceedings and wish to vote on the resolutions to be tabled at the SGM shall appoint the Chairman of the Meeting as his/her/its proxy to attend, speak and vote on his/her/its behalf at the SGM, in accordance with the instructions on the proxy form.

Specific Voting Instructions

Where a member (whether individual or corporate) appointing the Chairman of the Meeting as his/her/its proxy, he/she/it should give specific instructions as to voting (i.e. vote for or vote against), or abstentions from voting, in respect of a resolution in the proxy form, failing which the appointment of the Chairman of the Meeting as proxy for that resolution will be treated as invalid.

Submission of Proxy Forms

The instrument appointing the Chairman of the Meeting as proxy must be submitted to the Company in the following manner:

in either case, at least forty-eight (48) hours (i.e. by **1.30 p.m. on 20 April 2021, Tuesday**) before the time appointed for holding the SGM.

A member who wishes to submit a proxy form must first download, complete and sign the proxy form, before submitting it (by post to the address provided above, <u>or</u> before scanning and sending it by email to the email address provided above).

In view of the current Covid-19 situation and the related safe distancing measures which may make it difficult for members to submit the completed proxy forms by post, members are <u>strongly encouraged</u> to submit the completed proxy forms electronically via email.

Persons who hold shares of the Company through relevant intermediaries (as defined in Section 181 of the Companies Act, Chapter 50 of Singapore), including CPF or SRS investors who wish to appoint the Chairman of the Meeting as proxy should approach their respective CPF Agent Banks or SRS Operators to submit their votes by **1.30 p.m. on 13 April 2021, Tuesday**.
