## Structural steel specialist T T J secures new contracts bringing order book to a record \$217 million

**SINGAPORE** – **26 April 2018** – **T T J Holdings Limited** ("**T T J**" or together with its subsidiaries, the "**Group**") today announced it has successfully secured a series of new contracts, boosting its latest order book from \$136 million as at 7 March 2018 to \$217 million today. The Group expects to substantially complete the orders in its book between FY2018 and FY2021.
