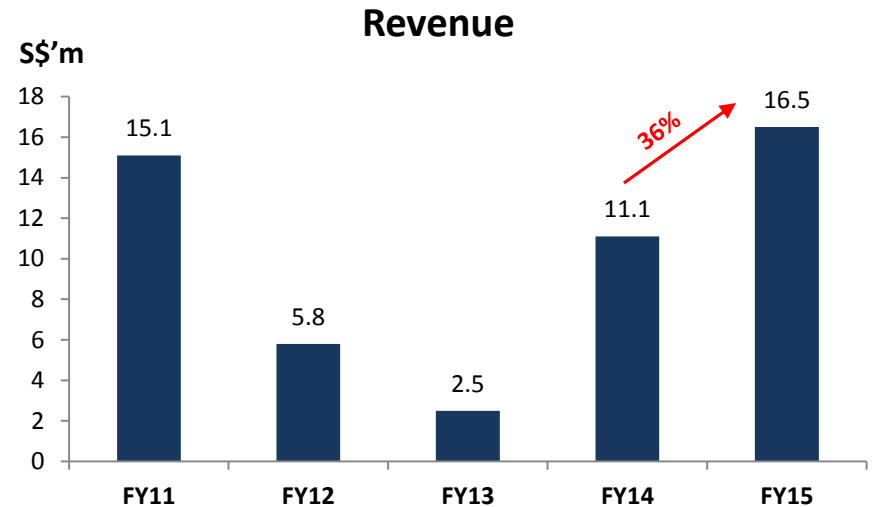
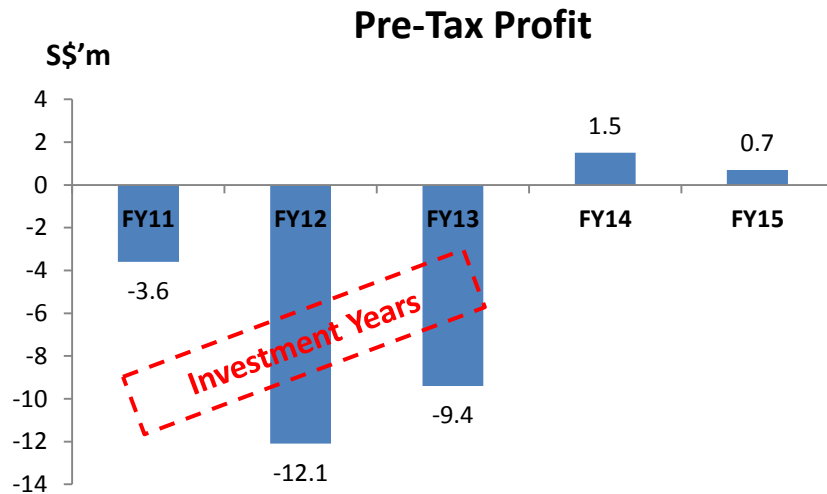

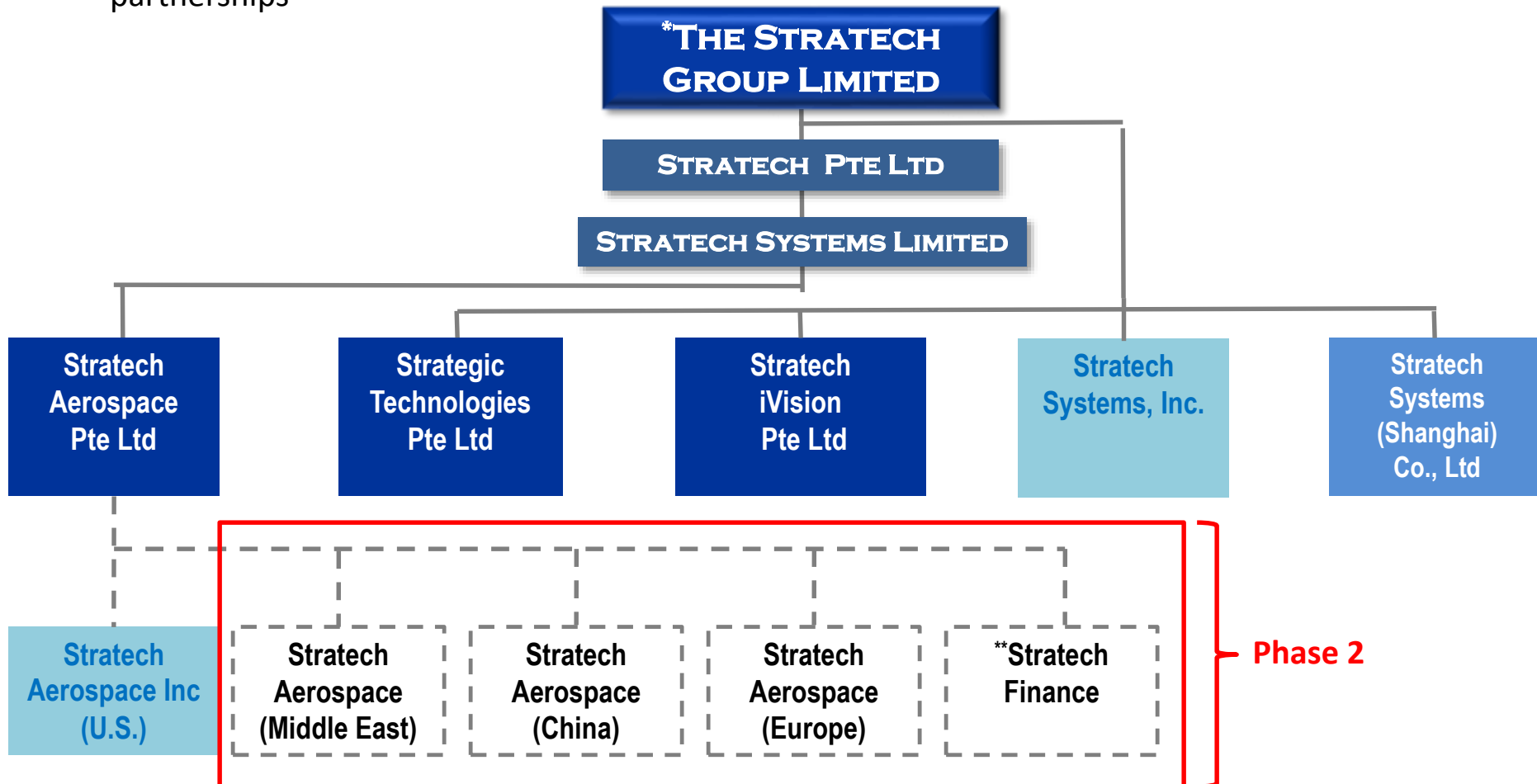

 - iFerret™ will be installed at Miami International Airport, which is one of the world's top commercial aviation hubs

From Tyndall Air Force Base, Florida :

Air Force engineers conducted qualification and evaluation tests on Stratech's iFerret and Super BullsEye Rapid Airfield Damage Assessment System, or RADAS, on 7 May 2015.

"This system has done very well," said Master Sgt Dan Linville, expeditionary modernization superintendent.

"We've expanded its use from identifying craters to also identifying unexploded ordnance. This particular test has allowed us to validate our training aids too."

There are more than 7,400 IATA registered commercial airports around the world but the Group will focus largely on the top airports

Top Airports of the World

- About **up to 3%** of IATA-registered airports, ranked by passenger traffic, total boardings and/or cargo traffic substantial

Market Situation

- Out of the **up to 3%** of IATA-registered airports, there are market information that some of these airports are moving towards implementing FOD detection systems
 - up to 0.5% of IATA airports over the next 3 to 5 years
 - up to 1% of IATA airports thereafter
