- (a)(i) The Group recorded a revenue of \$2.9 million, a decrease of \$0.5 million or 14% as compared with \$3.4 million in prior year, mainly due to lower number of students enrolled in Singapore and United Kingdom operations.
- (a)(ii) The Group recorded a loss before tax of \$1.6 million, which is \$0.2 million or 16% higher than prior year. This was mainly due to lower reveue and higher other operating expenses (explained in a(iv)) which was offset by lower employee benefits expense and depreciation expense.
- (b)(i) The Company's investment in subsidiaries declined by \$2.5 million or 16% to \$13.3 million as at 30 Sep 2016. This was due to an impairment loss recognised to reduce the investment to its recoverable amount.
- (b)(ii) The Group's prepayments increased by \$0.3 million or 51% to \$0.7 million as at 30 Sep 2016, mainly due to the prepayment of University Fees.
- (b)(iii) The Group's trade and other receivables increased by \$0.2 million or 7% to \$2.3 million as at 30 September 2016 mainly due to billings by UK operations. The Company's trade and other receivables decreased by \$0.2 million or 24% to \$0.5 million as at 30 September 2016 due to collections & intercompany settlement.
- (b)(iv) The Group's cash and fixed deposits declined by \$4.2 million or 28% to \$11.1 million as at 30 September 2016. The decline was mainly due to cash utilisation for operations. The Company's cash and fixed deposits increased by \$0.2 million or 85% to \$0.5 million as at 30 September 2016, mainly due to collections.
- (b)(v) The Group's deferred income and fees increased by \$0.2 million or 11% to \$1.6 million as at 30 September 2016. This was mainly attributed to collections by the Singapore School. This was however, offset by a \$0.1 million decrease in the Company's deferred income due to recognition of deferred exam revenue from the previous term.
- (b)(vi) The Group's trade and other payables decreased by \$0.3 million or 8% to \$3.3 million. This was mainly attributable to the repayment of University fees during the period. The Company's trade and other payables increased by \$1.3 million or 44% to \$4.3 million as at 30 September 2016 and this was mainly due to intercompany transactions.
- (b)(vii) The Company's net current liability position stands at \$3.3 million as at 30 Sep 2016. During the financial period, the Company had reduced income from its services to various clients due to a slowdown in their businesses, resulting in the deficit.
