UPDATE ON OPERATIONS ARISING FROM CIRCUIT BREAKER MEASURES BY SINGAPORE GOVERNMENT

On 3 April 2020, the Multi-Ministry Taskforce of the Singapore Government announced a set of elevated safe distancing measures to pre-empt the trend of increasing local transmission of COVID-19 ("Circuit Breaker Measures"). Save for those providing essential services and in selected economic sectors which are critical for local and global supply chains, physical workplace premises are required to temporarily suspend operations from 7 April 2020 until 4 May 2020.

The Board of Directors ("Board") of Manufacturing Integration Technology Ltd (the "Company" and together with its subsidiaries, the "Group") wishes to inform that the following Group's subsidiaries have successfully applied, and received approvals to operate as essential services and/or to support an essential services supply chain:

- (i) Casem (Asia) Pte Ltd
- (ii) Automated Manufacturing Solutions Pte. Ltd.

With the approval of the Singapore Ministry of Trade and Industry (the "MTI"), the above subsidiaries will be able to engage in the following activities at approved locations:-

- (a) Assembly of micro-positioners for the semiconductor industry,
- (b) Assembly, installation and commissioning of healthcare products manufacturing equipment.

During the period of the Circuit Breaker Measures, the Group's other staff in finance, human resources, administration etc will work from home.
