Sanli Awarded New Project with a Contract Value of S\$205.0 Million; Order Book Increases to a Record S\$838.7 Million

- **Awarded by PUB, Singapore's National Water Agency, the new project is for the development of Changi NEWater Factory 3 and the duration of the project is 24 months.**
- **Adding this new project with the largest single contract of S\$281.0 million recently secured in October 2025, the Group's order book has reached a record level of S\$838.7 million.**
- **Barring any unforeseen circumstances, the new project is expected to have a positive impact on the net tangible assets and earnings per share of the Group throughout the duration of the project.**

Recently, in October 2025, the Group was awarded a project from the Land Transport Authority ("**LTA**") with a contract value of approximately S\$281.0 million, which marks the largest single contract secured by the Group to date.

With the addition of this latest project, the Group's order book has reached a new record level of S\$838.7 million.
