

UPDATES ON MATTERS RELATING TO SUBSIDIARY – NOTICE OF INTENTION TO STRIKE OFF A-P ENGINEERING PTE LTD

The Board of Directors (the **"Board**") of Asian Micro Holdings Limited (the **"Company**"and the Company together with its subsidiaries, the **"Group**") wishes to announce that the Company has received a Notice from the High Court of the Republic of Singapore related to the intention of the Official Receiver and Liquidator of A-P Engineering Pte Ltd, a subsidiary of the Company (the **"Subsidiary**"),to strike off the Subsidiary under Section 344(3)(c) of the Companies Act (Cap 50), pursuant to the completion of the administration process.

The Company does not have any intention to object the strike off procedure.

The striking off of the Subsidiary stated above is not expected to have any material financial impact on the consolidated net tangible assets or consolidated earnings per share of the Company and its Group for the financial year ending 30 June 2015.

The Company will make further announcements to update shareholders, when necessary.
