CIVMEC SECURES FURTHER CONTRACTS ON MAJOR EAST COAST PROJECTS

SINGAPORE – 25 October 2016 – Australia-based **Civmec Limited** (“**Civmec**” or the “**Group**”) today announced the award of further contracts for major projects on the east coast of Australia to the combined value of approximately AUD\$30 million.

The contract wins include:

- **NRT Infrastructure JV (NRTIJV):** Supply and installation of structural steel components for several stations of Northwest Rail Link project, in North West Sydney, New South Wales.
- **Acciona Infrastructure:** Construction of a rail tunnel on the Sydney light rail project, New South Wales.
- **ThyssenKrupp:** Assembly and commissioning package for a Coal Terminal Reclaimer project near Wollongong, New South Wales.
- **WestConnex Project:** Various new packages of work for the Westconnex M4 East and M5 projects including the supply of precast and structural steel components, New South Wales.

North West Rail Link Project

Further to the recent award of precast supply and FRP packages for NRT Infrastructure JV (NRTIJV), Civmec has secured a further contract for the supply and installation of structural steel for the stations at Rouse Hill, Kellyville, Bella Vista and Cherrybrook. Fabrication will commence from our Newcastle facility in November 2016 with site erection commencing in January 2017

Sydney Light Rail – Moore Park Tunnel

Following the recent successful installation of the precast sections for an Eastern Distributor bridge, Civmec is delighted to continue its relationship with Acciona Infrastructure, with the award of work for the tunnel at Moore Park for the Sydney light rail project. Civmec will carry out installation of the 7,000m³ concrete structure.

Coal Terminal Reclaimer

Having recently delivered the fabrication packages for a Coal Terminal Reclaimer project, Civmec is now pleased to announce that we have been awarded further contracts for the final off-site assembly and commissioning assistance for the fabricated reclaimer and stackers. The scope of work includes the structural, mechanical and piping assembly, along with the electrical installation of the various units.

Westconnex Project

Civmec has received further packages on the WestConnex project, including the supply of precast parapets for the M4 East and the fabrication, supply and delivery of structural steel walers, struts and ring beams for the M5.

Mr. Patrick Tallon, Civmec Chief Executive Officer, said, “We are pleased that we have now established a presence as a key player in infrastructure work on the east coast of Australia.
