PROPOSED ISSUE OF UNLISTED, NON-CONVERTIBLE BONDS OF UP TO AN AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF S\$20,000,000

– COMPLETION OF BOND ISSUANCE TO THIRD TRANCHE SUBSCRIBERS

1. INTRODUCTION

The board of directors (the “**Board**” or the “**Directors**”) of Raffles Education Limited (the “**Company**”, and together with its subsidiaries, the “**Group**”) refers to the announcements dated 24 July 2024, 25 July 2024, 29 July 2024, 27 September 2024, 1 November 2024, 6 November and 28 November 2024 in relation to the Proposed Bond Issue (the “**Previous Announcements**”).

All capitalised terms used herein shall unless otherwise defined, have the meaning ascribed to them in the Company’s announcement dated 28 November 2024.

2. COMPLETION OF ISSUE OF AN AGGREGATE OF S\$750,000 OF BONDS

2.1. As announced in the Previous Announcements, the Company had completed the issuance of S\$15,500,000 in principal amount of Bonds to certain First Tranche Subscribers and Second Tranche Subscribers.

2.2. The Board wishes to announce that the Company has, on 28 November 2024, completed the issuance of S\$750,000 in principal amount of the Bonds to the Third Tranche Subscribers, as follows:

2.3 Accordingly, as of the date of this announcement an aggregate of S\$16,250,000 in principal amount of Bonds have been issued by the Company pursuant to the Proposed Bond Issue and the issuance of Bonds to the Third Tranche Subscribers have been completed.

2.4 The Company will continue to keep shareholders updated and make further announcement(s) as and when there are material developments in relation to the Proposed Bond Issue.
