UPDATE TO PATENT INFRINGEMENT COMPLAINT AGAINST AEM HOLDINGS LTD AND ITS SUBSIDIARIES

AEM Holdings Ltd. (the “**Company**”) refers to its announcements dated 6 October 2025 and 2 July 2026 in relation to the patent infringement litigation commenced by Advantest Test Solutions, Inc. (“**Advantest**”) against the Company and its subsidiaries, AEM Singapore Pte Ltd and AEM Americas, Inc., in the United States District Court for the Southern District of California.

As previously announced in our 2 July 2026 announcement, Advantest had alleged infringement of U.S. Patent Nos. 11,674,999 and 12,320,841 and the Court dismissed Advantest’s original complaint while granting Advantest leave to file an amended complaint.

The Company wishes to update shareholders that, on 21 July 2026 (Singapore time), it was notified by its U.S. counsel that Advantest has filed a First Amended Complaint on 20 July 2026. The amended complaint continues to allege infringement of U.S. Patent Nos 11,674,999 and 12,320,841 by AEM. As previously announced, the patents relate to a specific wafer-level test system that is not practiced by AEM.

AEM has its own extensive patent portfolio and respects the intellectual property of others. AEM continues to strongly deny Advantest’s allegations. The Company, together with its U.S. counsel, is reviewing the amended complaint and will take all appropriate steps to defend AEM’s position.

Based on the Company’s current assessment, the filing of the amended complaint is not expected to have any material impact on AEM’s business operations or financial position. The Company will continue to monitor the matter and will make further disclosures as required in accordance with the SGX Listing Rules.
