### **Revenue and Gross Profit**

The Group's revenue increased by 5.2% for the financial quarter ended 31 March 2014 ("1Q2014") year-on-year ("yoy") to \$\$152.7 million, mainly due to increased revenue from the Hard Disk Drive ("HDD") and non-HDD segments in the components division.

The revenue from the components division increased by 15.0% yoy to \$\$109.9 million in 1Q2014. HDD's revenue increased by 10.3% yoy to \$\$92.2 million in 1Q2014. Revenue from the non-HDD segment increased by 47.6% yoy to \$\$17.7 million in 1Q2014. The increase in the non-HDD segment was led by strong demand in the semi-conductor industry and new forays in the consumer devices market.

Revenue from the foam plastics division decreased by 13.7% yoy in 1Q2014 to S\$42.8 million, mainly due to a reduction in demand for the foam plastics packaging segment.

Gross profit decreased 35.8% yoy to \$\$9.0 million in 1Q2014 mainly due to decreased revenue from the foam plastics division and increased material and labour costs in both the foam plastics and components divisions. Gross profit margin contracted to 5.9% in 1Q2014 as compared to 9.7% in 1Q2013.

#### Other Income

The Group recorded other income of S\$2.3 million in 1Q2014 as compared to S\$2.8 million in 1Q2013. For 1Q2014, such income was mainly derived from the divestment of an asset held for sale.

### Operating Expenses

Distribution expenses decreased by 5.9% yoy to \$\$3.9 million in 1Q2014 due to lower revenue for the foam plastics division and improved logistics management resulting from the streamlining of production processes in the HDD segment of the components division.

Administrative expenses increased by 21.0% yoy to S\$7.8 million in 1Q2014 primarily due to redundancy expenses for Chengdu factory in the foam plastics division and for the streamlining of production processes in the HDD segment as well as costs associated with the increase in revenue for the non-HDD segment of the components division.

Sales and marketing expenses decreased by 16.1% yoy to S\$2.1 million in 1Q2014 due to reduction in revenue related expenses for the foam plastics division.

Other expenses increased to S\$4.4 million in 1Q2014 from S\$0.8 million in 1Q2013 mainly due to S\$4.0 million unrealised mark-to-market (MTM) fair value loss on financial derivatives.

## **Finance Costs**

Finance costs increased 22.6% yoy to \$\$1.9 million in 1Q2014 due to increased borrowings for the Group.

## Loss / Profit before Income Tax

The foam plastics division recorded a lower profit before tax of S\$1.6 million in 1Q2014 as compared to S\$6.1 million in 1Q2013 mainly due to lower revenue in the packaging segment.

The HDD segment of the components division recorded a loss of S\$6.1 million in 1Q2014 as compared to a loss of S\$3.1 million in 1Q2013 due to increased material and labour costs for the revenue mix and administrative costs incurred to streamline the production processes.

The non-HDD segment of the components division recorded a loss of S\$1.0 million in 1Q2014 as compared to profit of S\$0.3 million in 1Q2013 due to higher material, labour, overheads costs and the new forays into the consumer devices market.

### Tax Credit / Expense

The Group recorded a tax credit of S\$8.9 million for 1Q2014 as compared to a tax expense of S\$1.0 million in 1Q2013 mainly due to reversal of overprovision of income tax for prior years no longer required because of the expiry of the tax liability period.

## **Net Profit**

Due to the above factors, the Group recorded a profit after tax and minority interest of \$\$0.2 million as compared to \$\$0.5 million in 1Q2013.

### **Balance Sheet**

The Group's cash conversion cycle increased from 56 days as at 31 December 2013 to 65 days as at 31 March 2014. The lower payables turnover days in the foam plastics division mainly accounted for the increase in cash conversion cycle for the Group.

The Net Asset Value (NAV) per share of the Group decreased from 52.77 cents as at 31 December 2013 to 50.11 cents as at 31 March 2014. This was mainly due to foreign currency translation differences for foreign operations in the translation reserve.

## **Cash Flow**

The Group recorded net cash used in operating activities of S\$10.5 million in 1Q2014 as compared to net cash from operations of S\$11.0 million in 1Q2013 mainly due to the increase in the cash conversion cycle in 1Q2014.

Net cash used in investing activities decreased to S\$1.2 million in 1Q2014 as compared to S\$8.4 million in 1Q2013 mainly due to proceeds from the divestment of the asset held for sale in 1Q2014.

Net cash from financing activities was S\$4.1 million in 1Q2014 as compared to net cash used in financing activities of S\$1.8 million in 1Q2013 mainly due to higher bank borrowings in 1Q2014.

Cash and cash equivalents at 31 March 2014 was \$\$28.5 million as compared to \$\$18.6 million at 31 March 2013 mainly due to higher cash and cash equivalents at 1 January 2014.

The long term trend in the HDD industry is expected to remain flat. The Group has continued with its drive to right-size and streamline the manufacturing processes and logistics management for its HDD business segment.

In relation to our non-HDD business, the Group's efforts to diversify its income streams has met some success in the semiconductor business segment. Revenue for the consumer devices business segment is expected to improve in 2Q2014 and the Group continues to develop new programs and customers.

The Group is also continuing with its endeavours to expand the product range of the foam plastics division.

The Group remains cautious on its prospects for FY2014.
