### Samurai 2K Aerosol Limited Launches Proprietary Tintatek Colour Matching Technology Following ASEAN and Asia Record Achievement

- Officially recognised by ASEAN Records and Asia Records for the “Highest Number of Full-Body Car Spray Paints Using Aerosol in a Single Event”.
- Launch of Tintatek following five years of R&D, enhancing Samurai’s refinishing ecosystem.
- Expands addressable market through lower infrastructure requirements and support for localised automotive paint repairs.
- Profitable growth and strong balance sheet, enabling long-term value creation.

Singapore, **2 March 2026** – Samurai 2K Aerosol Limited (“Samurai” or the “Company”, and together with its subsidiaries, the “Group”) today announced the commercial launch of Tintatek, its proprietary post-filled colour matching technology, following its ASEAN and Asia record-setting “**Spray 30 cars in 3 Days Challenge.**”

Held earlier last month, the initiative saw 30 vehicles fully resprayed within 72 hours using Samurai’s 2K aerosol paint system. Vehicles were processed through coordinated preparation, colour application and clear coating stages under a standardised workflow, with owners spraying under guided supervision. The achievement was officially recognised on 8 February 2026 by ASEAN Records and Asia Records for the “**Highest Number of Full-Body Car Spray Paints Using Aerosol in a Single Event.**”

Mr Ian Ong Yoke En, Chief Executive Officer of Samurai 2K Aerosol Limited, said, “*The ‘Spray 30 cars in 3 Days’ challenge demonstrates that aerosol-based automotive repainting can extend beyond traditional workshop environments. Following five years of research and development, Tintatek strengthens our ecosystem with a colour-matching solution that reduces infrastructure requirements while maintaining precision. As aftermarket demand expands across ASEAN, we are focused on translating this capability into sustainable commercial growth through deeper distribution partnerships and continued innovation.*”

Developed over five years, **Tintatek** enhances Samurai’s refinishing platform by enabling accurate blending of repaired areas without reliance on capital-intensive colour-matching machinery. The compact system reproduces a broad spectrum of automotive colours from a limited pigment base, supporting localised applications such as scratch correction, panel repainting and partial resprays. By lowering infrastructure requirements, Tintatek expands applicability across cost-sensitive and infrastructure-light markets. The innovation was previously recognised with a Silver Medal at the Geneva International Exhibition of Inventions and is now commercially available through authorised distribution channels in key regional markets.

In its unaudited financial results for 6-months financial period ended 30 September 2025, the Group reported revenue of RM39.7 million, with gross margin maintained at approximately 50%. Profit before tax was RM19.1 million. As at 30 September 2025, cash and cash equivalent was RM39.5 million with net assets recorded at RM84.3 million, reflecting a strengthened balance sheet to support continued growth.

With automotive ownership expanding across Southeast Asia, demand for efficient and cost-conscious refinishing solutions remains supported. Samurai’s integrated aerosol and colour ecosystem positions it to participate in this evolving aftermarket landscape while reinforcing long-term brand and distribution strength.
