- (1) Cash and cash equivalents include approximately US\$14,162,000 (comprising the escrowed amount of US\$10,228,144, S\$1,112,225.66 and RMB20,972,195.40 as well as interest earned on the respective escrow accounts) placed in escrow accounts pursuant to Rule 1017(1)(a) of the Catalist Rules. Please refer to the Company's announcements dated 1 March 2019, 6 June 2019 and 30 July 2019 for further information on the Company becoming a cash company as defined under Rule 1017 of the Catalist Rules as well as updates on the establishment of the respective escrow accounts in Singapore and China.
- (2) Include, *inter alia*, directors' fees paid in arrears in respect of the fourth quarter of the financial year ended 31 December 2019, and withholding tax paid to Inland Revenue Authority of Singapore in relation to directors' fees paid to a Director who is a non-tax resident in Singapore. Both formed part of the directors' fees approved by shareholders at the annual general meeting held on 26 April 2019.
- (3) Include, *inter alia*, corporate secretarial fees, sponsorship fees, SGX annual listing fees and expenses incurred for the reverse take-over exercise.
- (4) The foreign exchange difference arose mainly from translation of balances or transactions denominated in Singapore Dollar and Chinese Renminbi.
