- (c) Assignment of, *inter alia*, all rights, title, interests and benefits arising out of all present and future leases of any units or part thereof of the Group's building located on the Changi Business Park Land (the "**Changi Business Park Headquarters**").

The Group's hire purchase facilities are secured against the respective motor vehicles.

The Group's unsecured credit facilities comprise (a) the loans extended by the Company's Non-Executive Chairman, Dato' Sri Dr. Lim Yong Guan, and the Company's Executive Directors, Mr. Lim Yong Sheng and Mdm. Lim Liang Eng, pursuant to the loan agreements dated 1 June 2015 (the "**Directors' Loans**") and (b) a loan of S\$1.20 million to the Company's 70%-owned subsidiary, SK Bullion Pte Ltd, from its minority shareholders.

#### **REVIEW OF THE GROUP'S PERFORMANCE**

#### Revenue

Revenue decreased by S\$4.28 million or 3.5% from S\$122.07 million in 9M-2016 to S\$117.79 million in 9M-2017 and decreased by S\$11.11 million or 22.3% from S\$49.80 million in Q3-2016 to S\$38.69 million in Q3-2017. The decrease in revenue for 9M-2017 as compared to 9M-2016 was mainly due to the decrease in demand for the Group's jewellery products and mementoes while the decrease in revenue for Q3-2017 as compared to Q3-2016 was mainly due to the decrease in sales by our subsidiary, SK Bullion Pte Ltd.

#### Other gains

Other gains decreased by S\$0.37 million or 28.8% from S\$1.29 million in 9M-2016 to S\$0.92 million in 9M-2017. This was mainly attributable to a decrease in government grants of S\$0.23 million and a decrease in miscellaneous and commission income.

In Q3-2017, other gains was S\$0.23 million, as compared to S\$0.30 million in Q3-2016. The decrease of S\$0.07 million was mainly due to a decrease in miscellaneous income of S\$0.16 million offset by foreign exchange adjustment gains of S\$0.07 million and rental income of S\$0.02 million.

#### Material costs

Material costs decreased by S\$3.16 million or 4.1% from S\$77.49 million in 9M-2016 to S\$74.33 million in 9M-2017 and decreased by S\$11.37 million or 31.3% from S\$36.37 million in Q3-2016 to S\$25.00 million in Q3-2017. The more than proportionate decrease in material costs as compared to the decrease in revenue in the respective periods was mainly due to the change in product mix.



#### Employee benefits expense

Employee benefits expense increased by S\$0.26 million or 6.0% from S\$4.34 million in Q3-2016 to S\$4.60 million in Q3-2017. The increase was mainly due to an (i) increase in employer's CPF contribution due to increase in CPF contribution rate, (ii) increase in salaries and sales commission and (iii) increase in recruitment expenses.

Employee benefits expense increased by S\$0.26 million or 1.9% from S\$13.91 million in 9M-2016 to S\$14.17 million in 9M-2017 for the same reasons as mentioned above.

#### Depreciation and amortisation expense

Depreciation and amortisation expense decreased by \$\$0.21 million or 6.6% from \$\$3.18 million in 9M-2016 to \$\$2.97 million in 9M-2017 and decreased by \$\$0.05 million or 4.7% from \$\$1.06 million in Q3-2016 to \$\$1.01 million in Q3-2017. The decrease was mainly due to lower depreciation expenses for renovations and plant and equipment for our Malaysian subsidiaries as certain fixed assets have been fully depreciated.

#### Other losses

The other losses, due mainly to a loss on disposal of property, plant and equipment, was relatively unchanged at S\$0.04 million in 9M-2016 and 9M-2017.

The decrease in other losses of S\$0.20 million in Q3-2017 as compared to Q3-2016 was due to an absence of foreign exchange adjustment losses of S\$0.13 million attributable to the weakening of the MYR which had been recognized in Q3-2016 and absence of loss on disposal of property, plant and equipment which was recognised in Q3-2016.

#### Finance costs

Finance costs decreased by S\$0.42 million or 26.8% from S\$1.56 million in 9M-2016 to S\$1.14 million in 9M-2017 and decreased by S\$0.10 million or 19.5% from S\$0.49 million in Q3-2016 to S\$0.39 million in Q3-2017. The decrease was mainly due to lower borrowings following the repayment of certain term loans facilities and the Directors' Loans.

#### Other expenses

Other expenses decreased by S\$0.55 million or 2.4% from S\$22.83 million in 9M-2016 to S\$22.28 million in 9M-2017 and decreased by S\$0.17 million or 2.3% from \$7.24 million in Q3-2016 to S\$7.07 million in Q3-2017. The decrease was mainly due to property tax refund.

#### Profit before tax

As a result of the foregoing, profit before tax decreased by S\$0.57 million or 13.0% from S\$4.34 million in 9M-2016 to S\$3.77 million in 9M-2017 and increased by S\$0.44 million or 108.7% from S\$0.40 million in Q3-2016 to S\$0.84 million in Q3-2017.

#### Income tax expense

Income tax expense increased by S\$0.14 million or 14.7% from S\$0.93 million in 9M-2016 to S\$1.07 million in 9M-2017 mainly due to provision for certain expenses which may not be tax deductible in 9M-2017.

Income tax expense increased by S\$0.15 million or 99.3% from S\$0.15 million in Q3-2016 to S\$0.30 million in Q3-2017 mainly due to the increase in profit before tax.



#### **REVIEW OF THE GROUP'S FINANCIAL POSITION**

#### Non-current assets

Non-current assets increased by S\$0.15 million or 0.4% from S\$39.76 million as at 31 December 2016 to S\$39.91 million as at 30 September 2017. This was mainly due to the (i) increase in property, plant and equipment of S\$0.17 million and (ii) increase in deferred tax assets of S\$0.14 million, partially offset by the decrease in other assets (land use rights) of S\$0.16 million.

The increase in property, plant and equipment was mainly due to capital expenditures incurred in relation to the construction costs for the Group's Changi Business Park Headquarters and purchase of other plant and equipment.

#### Current assets

Current assets decreased by \$\$13.34 million or 14.0% from \$\$95.48 million as at 31 December 2016 to \$\$82.14 million as at 30 September 2017. This was mainly due to the (i) decrease in cash and cash equivalents of \$\$10.34 million mainly due to repayment of trade payables for raw materials and finished goods purchased on credit terms of \$\$6.47 million and repayment of the Directors' Loans of \$\$2.73 million, (ii) decrease in inventories of \$\$3.43 million and (iii) decrease in trade and other receivables of \$\$0.63 million, partially offset by increase in other assets of \$\$1.06 million.

The decrease in inventories of S\$3.43 million was mainly due to the decrease in inventories held in Singapore.

#### Non-current liabilities

Non-current liabilities decreased by \$\$3.82 million or 11.1% from \$\$34.34 million as at 31 December 2016 to \$\$30.52 million as at 30 September 2017. This was mainly due to the repayment of certain term loans facilities of \$\$1.18 million and repayment of the Directors' Loans of \$\$2.70 million, partially offset by increase in other liabilities of \$\$0.06 million.

#### Current liabilities

Current liabilities decreased by \$\$9.25 million or 19.6% from \$\$47.15 million as at 31 December 2016 to \$\$37.90 million as at 30 September 2017. This was mainly attributable to (i) decrease in trade and other payables of \$\$6.47 million, (ii) decrease in other financial liabilities of \$\$1.00 million, (iii) decrease in income tax payable of \$\$1.17 million and (iv) decrease in other liabilities of \$\$0.61 million.

The decrease in trade and other payables was mainly due to settlement for the jewellery products purchased on credit terms.

The decrease in other financial liabilities was mainly due to the repayment of certain term loans facilities.

The decrease in income tax payables of S\$1.17 million or 52.6% from S\$2.23 million as at 31 December 2016 to S\$1.06 million as at 30 September 2017 was mainly due to income tax expenses provided for in 9M-2017 of S\$1.07 million which was offset by income tax payment of S\$2.24 million.

#### Total equity

Total equity decreased marginally by \$\$0.12 million or 0.2% from \$\$53.75 million as at 31 December 2016 to \$\$53.61 million as at 30 September 2017. The decrease was mainly due to the total comprehensive income, net of tax attributable to owners of the Company of \$\$2.79 million for 9M-2017 offset by (i) increase in foreign currency translation reserve (other reserves) of \$\$0.01 million, (ii) decrease in non-controlling interest of \$\$0.09 million and (iii) payment of ordinary dividends in respect of FY2016 of \$\$2.81 million in Q2-2017.



#### **REVIEW OF THE GROUP'S CASHFLOW STATEMENT**

For 9M-2017, net cash flows from operating activities was S\$1.50 million, which consisted of operating cash flows before changes in working capital of S\$7.76 million, net of income tax paid of S\$2.24 million and working capital outflows of S\$4.02 million.

The net working capital outflows arose mainly from the following:

- (a) (i) a decrease in trade and other payables of S\$6.47 million, (ii) decrease in other liabilities of S\$0.55 million and (iii) decrease in other assets of S\$1.06 million,
- (b) offset by (i) decrease in trade and other receivables of S\$0.63 million and (ii) decrease in inventories of S\$3.43 million.

For 9M-2017, net cash flows used in investing activities amounted to S\$3.03 million mainly due to the purchase of property, plant and equipment relating to capital expenditures incurred in relation to the construction costs for the Group's Changi Business Park Headquarters and purchase of other plant and equipment.

For 9M-2017, net cash flows used in financing activities was S\$8.81 million mainly due to (i) dividend payment of S\$2.81 million, (ii) loan repayment of S\$2.10 million, (iii) net movement in amounts due to directors of S\$2.73 million arising from the repayment of the Directors' Loans and (iv) interest payment of S\$1.14 million.

As a result of the above, there was a net decrease of S\$10.34 million in cash and cash equivalents for 9M-2017, from a net cash surplus of S\$27.49 million as at 31 December 2016 to a net cash surplus of S\$17.15 million as at 30 September 2017.

The local retail operating environment remains challenging as retailers continue to face margin pressures from weaker retail spending and labour costs. As cautious consumer spending continues, the Group will keep up its efforts to enhance customer engagement through the introduction of new initiatives and new product offerings so as to boost top-line growth.

Concurrently, the Group will continue to drive operational efficiencies such as improving its inventory turnover days which can generate savings from decreased inventory costs. In addition, to provide a source of recurring income, the Group has secured a tenant for a portion of the unutilised office space at its Changi Business Park Headquarters, and remains on the lookout for tenants for the remaining empty office space.

Beyond the retail scene in Singapore and Malaysia, the Group is actively expanding its regional footprint to generate new revenue streams. On 19 July 2017, the Group entered into a memorandum of understanding with Global Crown Group Holding Limited and Diamond Avenue Investments Limited (the "**JVC**") in relation to a proposed joint venture whereby the JVC shall develop and operate the business of selling gold and diamond products under the Group's bridal jewellery brand, *Love & Co.*, in both the People's Republic of China and Hong Kong Special Administration Region
