

Tigerair Operating Statistics September 2015

For the month of September 2015, the airline operations in Singapore recorded 3.8% year-on-year (y-o-y) decline in traffic to 730.1 million revenue passenger-kilometres (RPK), while capacity decreased by 3.7% to 893.2 million available seat-kilometres (ASK). Consequently, y-o-y passenger load factor decreased by 0.1 percentage point to 81.7%. The number of passengers carried fell by 1.3% y-o-y to about 393,000.

For the 12 months to September 2015, traffic declined by 3.0% y-o-y to 9.5 billion RPK, while capacity decreased by 6.3% to 11.6 billion ASK. Consequently, passenger load factor was 2.7 percentage points higher at 82.1%. The number of passengers carried fell by 4.4% to 5.1 million.
