The audit adjustments for year ended as 31 December 2017 proposed by auditor on 28 June 2019 had been updated up to date. Accordingly, the result for finance year ended as 31 December 2017 announced on 28 February 2018 had been restated, for the more detail on the restatement will be announced later when audit for year ended as 31 December 2017 has been completed.

Review of Consolidated Statement of Profit or Loss and Other Comprehensive Income

Revenue and cost of sales

During the period under review, revenue was generated from the sales of coke and coal and mainly by the subsidiary Tianjin Belong Faith Energy Minerals Co., Ltd (天津博朗信国际贸易有限公司) ("BLX"). The sales decreased 45% from S\$43.8 million as at 1Q2018 to S\$24.2 million as at 1Q2019. Accordingly ,the cost of sales decreased 50% from S\$43.4 million to S\$21.6 million. The decrease is mainly due to the decrease of unit price of coke and coal.

Selling expenses

Selling expenses mainly represents the staff cost, entertainment and agency expenses in relation to the sales of coke and coal during the year. Selling expense increased 18% from S\$0.3 million as at 1Q2018 to S\$0.4 million as at 1Q2019.

Other operating income

Other operating income for 1Q 2019 increased by S\$0.7 million. This was mainly due to the net exchange gain of S\$0.8 million.

Review of Consolidated Statement of Profit or Loss and Other Comprehensive Income - continued

Other operating expenses

Other operating expenses increased by 25% from S\$0.12 million in the corresponding period to S\$0.15 million in 1O 2019.

Profit for Quarter ended 31 March 2019

In view of the above, the Group recorded profit after tax of S\$2.5 million for 1Q 2019, as compared to profit after tax of S\$0.3 million for the corresponding period in 2018.

Review of Consolidated Statement of Financial Position

Cash and cash equivalents

Cash and cash equivalents of the Group decreased from S\$0.4 million at as 31 December 2018 to S\$0.3 million as at 31 March 2019. See the Review of Consolidated Statement of Cash Flows for details.

Trade receivables

The amount represents the receivables due from various coal business customers was S\$13.5 million as at 31 March 2019 decreased from S\$36.6 million as at 31 December 2018. Due to the improved relationship with customers, it took less time for the group to collect payment from customers.

Other receivables, deposits and prepayments

Other receivables, deposits and prepayments increased from \$\$46.8 million as at 31 December 2018 to \$\$49.0 million as at 31 March 2019 due to the deposit of \$\$2.0 million made to a supplier by one of the subsidiaries, BLX. In April 2019, the deposit was fully returned.

Trade payable

The amount represents the payables due to various coal business suppliers as at period end. Trade payables decreased from S\$24.8 million as at 31 December 2018 to S\$0.7 million as at 31 March 2019. The decrease in trade payables was mainly due to Group settlement of accounts before the financial period ended as at 31 March 2019.

Other payables and accruals

Other payables and accruals increased from S\$10.8 million as at 31 December 2018 to S\$11.2 million as at 31 March 2019.

Review of Consolidated Statement of Cash Flows

Net cash used in operating activities outflow for 1Q 2019 was S\$0.1 million compared to S\$0.8 million for the corresponding period in 2018. The Group is working towards a positive net cash. No cash generated from investing activities and financial activities in 1Q2019 and the corresponding period.
