ISSUE AND ALLOTMENT OF SHARES PURSUANT TO EXERCISE OF WARRANTS

The Board of Directors (the “**Board**”) of iX Biopharma Ltd. (the “**Company**”), and together with its subsidiaries, the “**Group**”) wishes to announce that on 8 April 2026, the Company has allotted and issued 10,000,000 new ordinary shares pursuant to the exercise of warrants at the exercise price of S\$0.06 per warrant share, following which the number of issued shares of the Company has increased from 1,038,324,529 shares to 1,048,324,529 shares.

The 10,000,000 new shares are allotted to Mr Eddy Lee Yip Hang, a Director and a substantial shareholder of the Company.

The new ordinary shares rank *pari passu* in all respects with the existing shares of the Company and are expected to be listed and quoted on the Singapore Exchange Securities Trading Limited on or around 10 April 2026. Pursuant to the aforesaid exercise of warrants, a cumulative total of 17,565,084 warrants, representing 30.54% of all warrants previously issued, have now been exercised and there are 39,944,395 outstanding warrants with an exercise price of S\$0.06 for each warrant share expiring on 18 July 2026.
