The accounting for lessors has not changed significantly.

Statement of profit or loss and other comprehensive income

Revenue

The Group's revenue decreased by approximately HK\$45,000 or 3.9% from approximately HK\$1.14 million for the six months ended 30 June 2018 ("1H18") to approximately HK\$1.10 million for 1H19.

The decrease in revenue was solely attributed to the decrease in interest income from the financing business due to a decrease in number of loan disbursements in the Asia (other than the Peoples' Republic of China (including Hong Kong) (the "PRC (including HK)") during 1H19 compared to 1H18.

The Company did not generate revenue from Nickel Ore during 1H18 and 1H19 due to export restrictions and domestic shipment has yet to take place.

Other income

Other income increased by approximately HK\$25,000 or 208.3% from approximately HK\$12,000 in 1H18 to approximately HK\$37,000 in 1H19. This was mainly attributed to an increase in bank interest income in 1H19 resulted from the increase in average cash and bank balances in 1H19 as compared to 1H18.

Administrative expenses

Administrative expenses decreased by approximately HK\$603,000 or 22.0% from approximately HK\$2.74 million in 1H18 to approximately HK\$2.14 million in 1H19. This was mainly attributed to lower expenses for the Nickel Ore operation due to (a) waiver of remuneration for certain directors in the Company's subsidiary, Hong Kong Silver Basic Group Limited ("**HK Silver**"); and (b) decrease in salary as a result of reduction in the number of staff.

Finance costs

Finance costs decreased by approximately HK\$13,000 or 1.7% from approximately HK\$766,000 in 1H18 to approximately HK\$753,000 in 1H19 due to lower interest paid on borrowings as a result of non utilization of bank loans during 1H19.

Other operating expenses

Other operating expenses of approximately HK\$24.38 million in 1H19 was related to impairment losses of other receivables, namely deposit paid to a supplier in the Philippines for the purchases of nickel ore ("**Deposit**").

As at 31 December 2018, trade and other receivables included an amount of approximately HK\$24.38 million Deposit. The supplier is owned by Mr Wang De Zhou ("Mr Wang"), the director and CEO of HK Silver. In substance, the Deposit is secured by personal guarantee from Mr Wang, guarantee from the minority shareholders of HK Silver and the charge of shares in a mining company which owns a nickel ore mining concession in Indonesia. Due to the uncertainty in the amount of recovery, the Group has made full provision for the Deposit for prudence purposes.

Share of profit of an associate

Share of profit of an associate, namely PT Global Linker Indonesia ("PT Global") of HK\$161,000 in 1H19 comprised mainly the exchange gain from monetary balances due to appreciation of United States Dollars against Indonesia Rupiah

Loss before taxation

As a result of the above, the Group had recorded a loss before taxation of approximately HK\$25.97 million (1H18: approximately HK\$2.35 million).

Statement of financial position

Non-current assets

Non-current assets increased by approximately HK\$162,000 from approximately HK\$2.94 million as at 31 December 2018 to approximately HK\$3.10 million as at 30 June 2019 due mainly to increase in investment in an associate as a result of a share of profit of an associate.

Current assets

Current assets decreased by approximately HK\$26.75 million from approximately HK73.20 million as at 31 December 2018 to approximately HK\$46.45 million as at 30 June 2019. This was mainly attributed to (a) a decrease in trade and other receivables due to the receipt of the remaining proceeds from the Disposal of JGL Group. (b) a decrease in trade and other receivables due the impairment losses of other receivables, namely the Deposit. (c) a decrease in financial assets at fair value through profit or loss due to repayment of the loans which were categorized as financial assets. Such decrease was partially offset by an increase in cash and cash equivalents.

Current liabilities

Current liabilities increased by approximately HK\$20.59 million from approximately HK\$19.21 million as at 31 December 2018 to approximately HK\$39.80 million as at 30 June 2019. The increase was mainly attributed to reclassification of convertible loans from non-current liabilities to current liabilities as the convertible bonds will mature in February 2020.

Non-current liabilities

Non-current liabilities decreased by approximately HK\$21.20 million from approximately HK\$21.21million as at 31 December 2018 to approximately HK\$5,000 as at 30 June 2019 due to reclassification of convertible loans from non-current liabilities to current liabilities as the convertible bonds will mature in February 2020.

Liquidity and cash flow

During 1H19, the Group's net cash generated from operating activities was approximately HK\$2.06 million. This was mainly attributed to: (a) decrease in loan and advances of approximately HK\$2.42 million; (b) decrease in trade and other receivables of approximately HK\$630,000; (c) loss before taxation from operations

with adjustments for non-cash items of approximately HK\$1.04 million; and (d) increase in trade and other payables of approximately HK\$57,000. The Group's net cash generated from investing activities was approximately HK\$4.54 million mainly due to receipt of the remaining proceeds arising from the disposal of subsidiaries in previous year. The Group's net cash used in financing activities was approximately HK\$1.46 million. This was mainly attributed to settlement of accrued interests of the convertible bonds. As a result of the above, the Group's net increase in cash and cash equivalents was approximately HK\$5.14 million.

As at 30 June 2019, the Group had cash and cash equivalents of HK\$17.11 million (31 December 2018: HK\$11.94 million.)

10. A commentary at the date of the announcement of the significant trends and competitive conditions of the industry in which the group operates and any known factors or events that may affect the group in the next reporting period and the next 12 months.

Nickel ore

As at the date of this announcement, the Group's supplier in Philippines has yet to obtain the export approvals for nickel ore due to new additional procedures from the relevant authorities. At the moment, it remains uncertain if such export approvals can be obtained. As the Group is unable to obtain export permits, it is exploring other arrangements which will enable it to sell to the overseas market. As of to date, no such other arrangements have been made.

For the repayment of Deposit, Mr Wang has provided a repayment plan to the Company of which first installment of US\$50,000 will commence by end of August 2019 and will be increased and repaid over a period of time depending on the level of future shipment of nickel ore ("Repayment Plan").

The Board is of the view that the viability of the Repayment Plan would depend on the cash flow to be generated from the nickel ore mines owned by Mr. Wang through domestic or/and export sales in the future, both of which are still uncertain at the present moment and it would take some time to have a clearer visibility to the situation. However, if there is still no progress in the Group's nickel ore trading business by 30 September 2019, the Board and the Management will evaluate the recoverability options including calling on the share pledge and guarantees. The Company will update the shareholders in due course.

The Group's associate, PT Global has obtained a specific license to sell nickel ore domestically in Indonesia and has received some orders for nickel ore for the domestic market. However, shipment is still pending due to shortage of working capital in PT Global. The 51% shareholder of PT Global, Fill Stone International Limited ("Fill Stone") has provided up to approximately USD800,000 of funding to PT Global todate but the funds are still insufficient to support the working capital required by PT Global. It is estimated that further USD1 to 2 million is required to finance the nickel ore supplies. In addition, there has been disagreement between the management of PT

Global, being Mr Wang and Fill Stone on the business plan and strategy as well as operational issues of PT Global after Fill Stone became the 51% shareholder of PT Global. The parties involved are still resolving the disagreement and this has also contributed to the delay in shipment. The management of PT Global is exploring other options to raise the required working capital for PT Global. In view of the challenges faced in the nickel trading business, the Company is also exploring the option to dispose the business.

Financing business
