Review of Group's performance For the 3 months ended 30 September 2016 (3Q2016)

Continuing Operations

The Group's revenue in 3Q2016 was \$9.2 million, a decrease of 80.9% from 3Q2015. The decrease was due mainly to a decrease in shipbuilding and chartering activities arising from the slowdown in the marine and offshore industry.

The decrease in cost of sales was due to a decrease in shipbuilding and vessel chartering activities, as well as cost reductions across the Group.

Gross profit in 3Q2016 was \$4.9 million, a decrease of 68.6% from 3Q2015. The decrease was due mainly to a decrease in shipbuilding activities arising from the slowdown in the marine and offshore industry.

The increase in gross profit margin in 3Q2016 as compared to 3Q2015 was mostly contributed by chartering activities.

The decrease in other operating income in 3Q2016 compared to 3Q2015 was contributed by lower gains arising from the sale of vessels from the Group's existing fleet in 3Q2016 and an out-of-court settlement of a legal case in 3Q2015.

The decrease in administration expenses was due mainly to lower personnel cost arising from a decrease in headcount, a decrease in legal fees and cost reductions across the Group.

The increase in other operating expenses was due mainly to impairment of property, plant and equipment and inventory and a net foreign exchange loss of \$72,000 in 3Q2016, compared to a net foreign exchange gain of \$2.1 million in 3Q2015.

As a result of the above, the Group posted a loss from continuing operations of \$192,000 in 3Q2016, compared to a gain of \$12.0 million in 3Q2015.

Discontinued Operation

The Group ceased the business activities of its bunkering subsidiary in late FY2013. As a result of the cessation, this subsidiary's financials have been classified as "Discontinued Operation".

For the 9 months ended 30 September 2016 (9M 2016)

Continuing Operations

The Group's revenue for 9M 2016 was \$26.0 million, a decrease of 75.6% over that of the previous corresponding period. The decrease was due mainly to a decrease in shipbuilding and chartering activities arising from the slowdown in the marine and offshore industry.

The decrease in cost of sales was due to a decrease in shipbuilding and vessel chartering activities, as well as cost reductions across the Group.

Gross profit in 9M 2016 was \$10.7 million, a decrease of 68.0% from 9M 2015. The decrease was due mainly to a decrease in shipbuilding activities arising from the slowdown in the marine industry.

The increase in gross profit margin in 9M 2016 as compared to 9M 2015 was mostly contributed by a higher gross profit margin from ship repair and chartering activities.

The decrease in other operating income in 9M 2016 cpmpared to 9M 2015 was contributed by lower gains arising from the sale of vessels from the Group's existing fleet in 9M 2016 and an out-of-court settlement of a legal case in 9M 2015.

The decrease in administration expenses was due mainly to lower personnel cost arising from a decrease in headcount, a decrease in legal fees and cost reductions across the Group.

The increase in other operating expenses was due mainly to impairment of property, plant and equipment and inventory in 9M 2016 and a net foreign exchange loss of \$49,000 in 9M 2016, compared to a net foreign exchange gain of \$1.4 million in 9M 2015.

As a result of the above, the Group posted a loss from continuing operations of \$5.8 million in 9M 2016, compared to a gain of \$23.9 million in 9M 2015.

Discontinued Operation

The Group ceased the business activities of its bunkering subsidiary in late FY2013. As a result of the cessation, this subsidiary's financials have been classified as "Discontinued Operation".

Changes in Balance Sheet

The decrease in inventories was due mainly to some of the completed vessels being transferred to property plant and equipment and used for the Group's chartering activities.

The net increase in finance lease receivables, trade receivables and other receivables was due mainly to timing of collections during the period.

The decrease in trade payables and other payables and accruals was due mainly to timing of payment made during the period and the decrease in shipbuilding activities.

Review of Group Cashflow

The net cash of \$21.8 million used in operating activities was due mainly to payments for trade and other payables and timing of collection from receivables.

The net cash of \$550,000 from investing activities arose mostly from the disposal of existing fleet vessels, which was partially offset by addition of new crewboats for the Group's fleet.

The net cash of \$4.2 million used in financing activities was due mainly to repayment of term loans and a dividend payment as approved by the Company's shareholders at its Annual General Meeting held on 21 April 2016.

As a result of the above cash movements, the Group's cash and cash equivalents decreased to \$11.5 million as at 30 September 2016, from \$37.0 million as at 31 December 2015.

Worsening sentiments in the marine and offshore industry have dampened demand for the Group's crewboats and Fast Supply Intervention Vessels. The Group has already halted its build-for-stock programme and switched to a build-to-order strategy, with a focus on non-offshore vessels, including passenger ferries, patrol boats and special purpose vessels. Meanwhile, the Group is continuing to actively market its stock of completed Flex crewboats.

Mindful of the challenging market conditions, the Group will seek out cost reductions, while continuing its ongoing programme of developing niche high-speed vessel designs targeted at profitable market segments.
