This redesignation is in line with the provision of the Code of Corporate Governance 2018 to have separate persons to hold chairman and chief executive officer positions to ensure an appropriate balance of power, increased accountability, and greater capacity of the Board for independent decision making.

Madam Hao was appointed as a Non-Executive Director of the Company on 14 April 2021. She is a director of OOWAY Group Ltd., one of the controlling shareholders of the Company. Madam Hao is also a director of OOWAY Holding Ltd. and a director of OOWAY Technology Pte. Ltd., an associated company of the Group and a director of OOWAY Data Technology (Beijing) Co., Ltd. (Dalushujukeji (Beijing) Youxiangongsi) and Firefly Technology Pte. Ltd., wholly-owned subsidiaries of OOWAY Technology Pte. Ltd.. Madam Hao's experience will add value to the Group's recent diversification into the artificial intelligence, machine learning and data science business.

Following the redesignation, Mr Lim Wee Li will remain as CEO of the Group and he will continue to be responsible for the formulation of its strategic direction and business expansion plans.
