**ANNOUNCEMENT IN CONNECTION WITH
THE EXCHANGE OFFER IN RELATION TO THE S\$53,800,000 7.00 PER CENT. FIXED RATE
NOTES DUE 2026 COMPRISED IN SERIES 006 (ISIN: SGXF39931450) (THE "EXISTING NOTES")
ISSUED BY HEETON HOLDINGS LIMITED ("HEETON")
AND
THE ISSUE OF S\$90,000,000 5.50 PER CENT. NOTES DUE 2030 COMPRISED IN SERIES 007
(ISIN: SGXF13407741) BY HEETON PURSUANT
TO ITS S\$300,000,000 MULTICURRENCY DEBT ISSUANCE PROGRAMME (THE
"PROGRAMME")**

Reference is made to the announcements made by Heeton on 12 June 2026, 23 June 2026 and 24 June 2026 in relation to the Invitation and the New Issue (collectively, the "Announcements").

Heeton is pleased to announce that it has today issued S\$90,000,000 5.50 per cent. notes due 2030 under the Programme (the "Series 007 Notes"), comprising S\$43,000,000 in aggregate principal amount of New Notes issued as part of the Exchange Consideration and S\$47,000,000 in aggregate principal amount of Additional Notes issued pursuant to the New Issue.

CIMB Bank Berhad, Singapore Branch and United Overseas Bank Limited are the dealer managers in relation to the Invitation and the joint lead managers in relation to the New Issue.

The Series 007 Notes were issued at an issue price of 100 per cent. of their principal amount and in denominations of S\$200,000. The Series 007 Notes will bear interest at a rate of 5.50 per cent. per annum, payable semi-annually in arrear. The Series 007 Notes will constitute direct, unconditional, unsubordinated and unsecured obligations of Heeton and shall at all times rank *pari passu*, without any preference or priority among themselves, and *pari passu* with all other present and future unsecured obligations (other than subordinated obligations and priorities created by law) of Heeton.

Unless previously redeemed or purchased and cancelled, the Series 007 Notes shall mature on 2 January 2030.

The net proceeds arising from the issue of the Series 007 Notes (after deducting issue expenses) will be used for general corporate purposes, corporate funding and general working capital, including, but not limited to, the financing and refinancing of investment opportunities and potential acquisitions which the Group may pursue from time to time, and the refinancing of existing indebtedness of Heeton or its subsidiaries.

Pursuant to Condition 6(e)(iii) of the Series 007 Notes, a "Change of Shareholding Event" will occur when the aggregate interest, whether direct or deemed (as the term is described in Section 7 of the Companies Act 1967 of Singapore), of Mr Toh Giap Eng and his Immediate Family Members (as defined in the terms and conditions of the Series 007 Notes) in the shares of Heeton falls below 40 per cent. of the issued share capital of Heeton. Upon the occurrence of a "Change of Shareholding Event", each holder of the Series 007 Notes has an option to require Heeton to redeem the Series 007 Notes of such holder (subject to the terms and conditions of the Series 007 Notes).

Approval in-principle has been received from the Singapore Exchange Securities Trading Limited (the "**SGX-ST**") for the listing and quotation of the Series 007 Notes on the SGX-ST. The SGX-ST assumes no responsibility for the correctness of any of the statements made, opinions expressed or reports contained herein. Approval in-principle from the SGX-ST for the listing and quotation of the Series 007 Notes and admission to the Official List of the SGX-ST are not to be taken as an indication of the merits of Heeton, its subsidiaries, its associated and joint venture companies (if any), the Programme or the Series 007 Notes. The Series 007 Notes are expected to be listed on the SGX-ST on or about 3 July 2026.

Certain controlling shareholders, directors and the chief executive officer of Heeton and their associates (as defined in the SGX Listing Manual) have subscribed for an aggregate amount of S\$38,400,000, which comprises approximately 42.67 per cent. of the total principal amount of the Series 007 Notes.

Following the cancellation of the Existing Notes which have been offered and accepted for exchange pursuant to the Invitation, the aggregate principal amount of the Existing Notes outstanding will be S\$10,800,000. Unless previously redeemed or purchased and cancelled, such Existing Notes shall mature on 3 November 2026.

Capitalised or other terms used but not defined herein shall, unless the context otherwise requires, have the meanings as set out in the Announcements and the exchange offer memorandum dated 12 June 2026.
