## ST Engineering Announces Leadership Change at ST Kinetics

*Singapore, 30 March 2017* - Singapore Technologies Engineering Ltd (ST Engineering) today updated the leadership change in ST Kinetics as outlined in its earlier announcement on 14 November 2016.
