### **RESPONSE TO QUERY REGARDING TRADING ACTIVITY**

Such information may include events that are potentially material and price-sensitive, such as discussions and negotiations that may lead to joint ventures, mergers, acquisitions or purchase or sale of a significant asset. You may refer to paragraph 8 in Appendix 7.1 of the Mainboard Rules for further examples. - If yes, the information shall be announced immediately.

### The Company's Response:

To date, there is no material development which is required to be announced pursuant to the Listing Manual of the Singapore Exchange Securities Trading Limited. Accordingly, we are not aware of any information not previously announced concerning SingPost or our subsidiaries or associated companies which may explain the trading activity.

#### **Question 2:**
