UPDATE ON GROUP'S NEW BUSINESS OPERATIONS

The Board of Directors (the “**Board**”) of Digilife Technologies Limited (the “**Company**”, together with its subsidiaries, the “**Group**”) wishes to provide a business update on the Group’s operations in relation to its recently acquired autoclaved aerated concrete (“**AAC**”) business. In this regard, the Board further announces that its subsidiary, Brimax AAC Products LLP (“**Brimax**”), has changed its name to Modi Hebel India LLP (“**Modi Hebel**”), following the approval of the statutory authorities in India.

Change of Name of Subsidiary – Brimax AAC Products LLP to Modi Hebel India LLP

The rebranding reflects the Group’s strategic focus on strengthening its presence in the building materials and construction solutions sector, particularly in India. The new name “Modi Hebel India LLP” aligns with the Group’s long-term vision to establish a strong and differentiated brand in the AAC market.

The “Hebel” brand is widely recognised globally for AAC construction technology and is regarded as a market leader in AAC building solutions, with a proven track record in several developed markets including Australia, Japan and Europe. The Company has obtained the necessary approvals from the concerned trademark stakeholders to use the “Hebel” brand in India, and accordingly the subsidiary has adopted the name “Modi Hebel India LLP” to reflect the use of this brand in its operations.

The adoption of the “Hebel” brand is expected to support the Group’s strategy to develop and market AAC-based construction solutions in India by leveraging the strong recognition and technological reputation associated with the brand.

Modi Hebel will undertake all necessary updates to statutory registrations, licences, and corporate records, including regulatory filings, GST registrations, and digital platforms with relevant authorities in India, in due course. This development forms part of the Group’s broader strategy to expand its presence in high-growth construction markets.

Upgradation of AAC Plant of the Subsidiary as part of future plans

The Board wishes to announce that the manufacturing operations of its subsidiary, Modi Hebel India LLP (formerly known as Brimax AAC Products LLP), barring any unforeseen circumstances, will be temporarily suspended tentatively until October 2026 to facilitate the installation and commissioning of upgraded machinery at its manufacturing facility as part of future plans

disclosed in the Company's Circular dated 22 October 2025 under section 3.11, "Prospects and Future Plans for the Target Partnership and Proposed New Business".

During the period of temporary suspension, the manufacturing operations at Modi Hebel will cease and the Group will not generate revenue from the plant, which is expected to have a material impact on the Group's revenue contribution from this segment. The temporary suspension is necessary to safely facilitate the installation, modification and commissioning of the upgraded machinery and related plant infrastructure required for the proposed upgrade from AAC block manufacturing to AAC panel manufacturing.

The temporary suspension relates only to the manufacturing activities at the plant facility and does not affect the Company's corporate operations, management functions, ongoing stakeholder engagements, financing discussions or other administrative activities, all of which will continue as usual during the temporary suspension period. Upon completion of the upgrade, the facility is expected to resume operations in or around October 2026 with enhanced production capabilities.

This plant upgrade forms part of the Group's strategic initiative to enhance the manufacturing capabilities of the facility by enabling the production of AAC panels, in addition to the existing AAC block products. The estimated capital expenditure for the proposed upgrade is approximately INR 38 crore, of which approximately INR 14 crore has already been incurred by the Group. The remaining funding requirements are currently being discussed with financial institutions and strategic partners. The upgrade involves the procurement, installation and commissioning of new machinery, as well as necessary plant modifications.

Notwithstanding the temporary suspension of manufacturing operations until around October 2026, the Board and Management are of the view that the Company will continue to operate as a going concern, taking into consideration the Company's existing financial resources, ongoing financing discussions, capital expenditure requirements and ongoing loan repayment obligations.

The Board believes that the proposed upgrade from AAC block manufacturing to AAC panel manufacturing is expected to improve operational efficiency and positively contribute to the Group's revenue and long-term growth prospects in the building materials sector upon the expected resumption of operations in October 2026, barring any unforeseen circumstances.
