**EXCELPOINT PARTNERS SP GROUP TO DEVELOP  
LOW-POWER AND COST-EFFECTIVE POWER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM**

**Singapore, 13 September 2018** – Excelpoint Systems (Pte) Ltd (“Excelpoint”), a subsidiary of SGX mainboard-listed Excelpoint Technology Ltd., and SP Group (“SP”) are collaborating to develop a low-power and cost-effective Power Quality (“PQ”) metering system that will optimise power distribution across the city. This collaboration is part of the Singapore Power Energy Advanced Research and Development (“SPEAR”) programme under the SP Centre of Excellence (“SP CoE”). SP CoE is an initiative supported by the Singapore Economic Development Board (“EDB”).

The PQ metering system is a highly scalable and compact solution that will reduce the likelihood of power outages, while facilitating the adoption of renewable sources of energy to the grid. It will measure, collect and analyse data to prevent breaching of thermal and voltage limits of the power networks, thus providing stable and continuous power distribution.

In line with Excelpoint’s efforts to go beyond just playing the hardware role in the electronics technology value chain, this innovative project will tap on its research and development (“R&D”) capabilities in creating novel designs and solutions for energy-efficient and industrial power supply applications. It is also part of SP Group’s ongoing initiatives to harness latest power-saving technologies to achieve higher levels of energy efficiency.

The system will also help to better meet electricity needs, by increasing reliability and energy savings, enhancing energy security and promoting environmental sustainability.
