# **Review of Operating Results**

### Revenue

Revenue for 1Q 2016 decreased by 12.6% to US\$7.5 million, compared to US\$8.5 million in 1Q 2015, mainly due to the decrease in customers' orders.

### Cost of sales

Cost of sales for 1Q 2016 decreased by 14.8% to US\$5.3 million, compared to US\$6.2 million in 1Q 2015. That's in line with lower sales activities coupled with the decrease in depreciation expense, as a result of the expiry of useful lives of plant and equipment.

# Other operating expenses

Other operating expenses for 1Q 2016 decreased by 31.4% to US\$0.2 million compared to US\$0.3 million in 1Q 2015, mainly due to the foreign exchange loss recognized in 2015.

# **Financial position of the Group**

### Cash

Cash decreased by 14.2% to US\$8.0 million as at 31 March 2016, compared to US\$9.3 million as at 31 December 2015, mainly due to the payment of FY2015 year-end bonus in Q1 2016.

### Trade receivables

Trade receivables increased by 27.5% to US\$6.8 million as at 31 March 2016, compared to US\$5.3 million as at 31 December 2015, mainly due to slower repayment from customers.

## Other payables

Other payables decreased by 31.5% to US\$4.3 million as at 31 March 2016, compared to US\$6.3 million as at 31 December 2015, mainly due to the payment of FY2015 year-end bonus in February 2016.

For 1Q 2016, revenue increased by 4.0% from US\$7.2 million in 4Q 2015 to US\$7.5 million. The result is consistent with the Group's earlier guidance.



# A commentary at the date of the announcement of the significant trends and competitive conditions of the industry in which the group operates and any known factors or events that may affect the group in the next reporting period and the next 12 months.

The Group continues to show resiliency, maintaining net profitability for 1Q 2016, despite a difficult start in the year brought about by sluggish global semiconductor sales and exacerbated by the Tainan earthquake in February, which resulted in wafers shipment delays from major semiconductor manufacturers.

Latest data from Gartner indicate that the industry outlook remains dampened in 2016 due to a reduced demand for semiconductors as global IT spending is expected to decline 0.5% in 2016, alongside worldwide semiconductor revenues, which are forecasted to decline 0.6% from 2015. Against these headwinds, the Group remains focused in maintaining its profitability by taking measures to optimize our operations and costs.
