1. Completion of Acquisition of Lippo Mall Kuta

Further to the announcements dated 8 January 2016 and 15 August 2016 by LMIRT Management Ltd., in its capacity as manager of Lippo Malls Indonesia Retail Trust ("LMIR Trust" and as manager of LMIR Trust, the "Manager"), in relation to the proposed acquisition of Lippo Mall Kuta (the "Acquisition") by LMIR Trust, the Manager is pleased to announce the completion of the Acquisition today.
