Stratech posts 1HFY16 revenue of S\$2.1m; has started work on recent wins

- Earnings driven mainly by projects results reflect lower project activity level for 1H FY16, in line with project milestones for ongoing work
- Activity level to rise from 2H FY16; ongoing efforts to remain cost-effective and careful project execution expected to enhance margins and cashflow
- Group continues to focus on adding to its iFerret[™] orderbook so as to grow a steady earnings stream over the medium term

In line with its scheduled project milestones, The Stratech Group Limited (Stratech or the Group) reported a revenue of S\$2.1 million for the six months ended 30 September 2015 (1H FY16), compared with S\$9.2 million for the previous corresponding period.

As a result of lower project activity level during the period under review, the Group posted a net loss of S\$3.7 million. Stratech is currently at work installing its proprietary iFerretTM intelligent airfield/runway surveillance and foreign object & debris (FOD) detection system at Dubai International Airport, Hong Kong International Airport and Singapore's Changi Airport.

Executive Chairman Dr David K.M. Chew said: "On top of these ongoing projects, we have also started work on recent wins, which will lift the Group's activity level from 2H FY16.

"As our business is driven largely by projects, our earnings are dependent on the various project phases . We might also experience delays in the issue of tenders and award of contracts, and there is inherent uncertainty of success because of competition."

Nevertheless, the Group's intensive marketing and sales efforts have seen iFerretTM gain new ground. Just last month, it secured a second upgrade contract for the iFerretTM system at Changi Airport; the first was awarded in April this year. Stratech also clinched its first contract for a US commercial airport in July. Under the contract, it will install and maintain iFerretTM at Miami International Airport.

Dr Chew added: "We remain focused on growing our orderbook for projects and maintenance work in order to build a steady earnings stream over the medium term. At the same time, our persistent efforts to stay cost-effective and our careful project execution are expected to enhance margins and cashflow.

"The Group has submitted proposals for tenders for several major international airports and is in the midst of preparing proposals for several other tenders in different countries. iFerretTM is a tested and highly effective system, and we are optimistic that we shall be successful in some of these tenders."
