#### (i) INCOME STATEMENT

#### Fourth Quarter

For the three months ended 30 June 2015 ("Q42015"), the Group's turnover increased by 21% from RM 78.7 million to RM 95.3 million, when compared with the previous corresponding period ("Q42014"). Turnover from the Group's healthcare business accounted for approximately RM 16.1 million of the increase mainly due to higher patient load and average bill sizes in its two hospitals i.e. Mahkota Medical Centre Sdn. Bhd. ("MMCSB") and Regency Specialist Hospital Sdn. Bhd. ("RSHSB"). The Group's education business registered a RM 0.5 million increase in revenue due to higher student headcount.

Gross profit margin improved to 28.1% from 26.0% in the prior period due to effect cost management. Interest income was 71% lower in Q42015 due to lower amounts owing by associated companies upon the completion of the exercise to restore the Group's ownership of certain hospital assets previously transferred to associated companies. This transaction was completed in Q32015 and announced via SGXNet on 13 March 2015 as a reversal of previous asset restructuring ("Asset Restructuring").

#### (i) INCOME STATEMENT (Continued)

#### Fourth Quarter (Continued)

Distribution & marketing expenses in Q42015 were comparable to Q42014. Administrative expenses increased by RM 3.6 million as compared to the previous financial period mainly due to increase in general operating costs as a result of higher patient volume and RM 1.3 million share-based expenses recorded compared to none in Q42014. Finance costs increased by 29% mainly due to the higher amounts owing to associated companies with the completion of the Asset Restructuring in March 2015. Share of results of associates was RM 3.2 million lower when compared to the corresponding period in the prior year because investment properties previously held by the associated companies had been transferred to the Group as part of the Asset Restructuring. As such, there were no revaluation gains recognized by the associated companies in Q42015.

As a result of the above, the Group registered a 5% decrease in profit before tax of RM 14.1 million in Q42015, as compared to RM 14.9 million in Q42014. Tax expense decreased significantly by RM 7.6 million, mainly due to the recognition of deferred tax assets, arising from unutilized tax losses, by RSHSB, amounting to RM 9.0 million. The profit attributable to shareholders was RM 7.8 million and RM 5.2 million in Q42015 and Q42014 respectively, whereas profit attributable to non-controlling interests was RM 11.9 million and RM 7.7 million in Q42015 and Q42014 respectively.

#### Twelve Months

For the financial year ended 30 June 2015 ("FY2015"), the Group's turnover increased by 18% from RM 292.9 million to RM 345.2 million, when compared with the previous corresponding period ("FY2014"). Turnover from the Group's healthcare business accounted for approximately RM 51.0 million of the increase mainly due to higher patient load and average bill sizes in its two hospitals. The Group's education business registered a RM 1.3 million increase in revenue due to higher student headcount.

Gross profit margin for the current and prior financial years remained consistently strong at 30%. Interest income was 0.8 million lower in FY2015 due to lower amounts owing by associated companies due to the Asset Restructuring. Higher foreign exchanges losses on weakening Malaysian ringgit (RM 3.7 million) and the absence of non-recurring one-off sponsorships received in the first half of FY2014 resulted in other losses of RM 0.6 million for FY2015, compared to a RM 1.2 million of Other gains in FY2014.

Distribution & marketing expenses for FY2015 ended were comparable to the prior financial year. Administrative expenses increased by RM 4.8 million as compared to the previous financial year mainly due to RM 3.0 million of share-based expenses recorded for the first time this year. The remaining increase can be attributable to higher general operating expenses as a result of higher patient volume and higher depreciation expenses as a result of the Asset Restructuring. The rate of increase was lower than the rate of increase in turnover mainly due to improved cost management. Finance expenses for the current financial year decreased by RM 0.2 million due to the repayment of bank borrowings during the year and offset by higher finance costs arising from higher amounts owing to associated companies.

As a result of the above, the Group registered a 19% increase in profit before tax of RM 54.8 million for FY15, as compared to RM 46.2 million in the prior period. Tax expense decreased significantly by RM 8.8 million mainly due to the reversal of deferred tax liabilities in Q32015 as a result of the Asset Restructuring and recognition of deferred tax assets of approximately RM 9.0 million by RSHSB. The profit attributable to shareholders was RM 27.6 million and RM 16.0 million in the current and prior years respectively, whereas profit attributable to non-controlling interests was RM 25.7 million and RM 20.0 million in the financial years ended 2015 and 2014 respectively.

#### (ii) BALANCE SHEET

The RM 16.7 million increase in current trade and other receivables was mainly attributable to higher credit sales. Inventories increased by RM 7.5 million for which RM 5.8 million of the increase can be attributed to the restoration of the Group's ownership of clinic suites, which are held for sale, as part of the Asset Restructuring. Higher turnover for financial year ended 30 June 2015 contributed to the rest of the increase in inventories of medical drugs and supplies held.

The RM 37.9 million increase in property, plant and equipment was largely due to the Asset Restructuring in Q32015. Deferred tax assets increased by RM 9.0 million as a result of recognition of deferred tax assets, relating to unutilized tax losses, by RSHSB.

Repayment of term loans, bank overdrafts and hire purchase facilities by the two hospitals during the period resulted in a decrease in total borrowings by RM 14.8 million. Deferred tax liabilities increased by RM 3.7 million as a result of increase in property, plant and equipment in MMCSB as a result of the Asset Restructuring.

#### (iii) CASH FLOW STATEMENT

#### Fourth Quarter

Net cash from operating activities for the quarter was RM 7.2 million, RM 6.0 million lower than that in the previous period. This was mainly due to higher trade and other receivables and lower trade and other payables balances in Q42015. Net cash provided by investing activities for the current period was RM 2.9 million, an increase of RM 6.4 million as a result of higher repayment of loans from associated companies and a decrease in acquisition of property, plant and equipment. Net cash used in financing activities was higher by RM 2.6 million, when compared to the corresponding period in the prior year, mainly due to RM 2.2 million lower dividend payment made to non-controlling interests during the current period.

#### Twelve months

Net cash generated from operating activities for the financial year was RM 48.0 million, RM 2.8 million higher than that in the previous year. This was mainly due to higher operating profit in the current year and higher trade and other payables balances as a result of the Asset Restructuring in Q32015, offset by higher trade and other receivables. Net cash used in investing activities was RM 7.5 million, mainly due to acquisition of new medical equipment by the hospitals. Net cash used in financing activities for the current period was RM 23.9 million, RM 6.1 million higher than the prior year, mainly due to higher loan repayment.

The Group's hospitals continue to do well with both hospitals in Malaysia registering increases in revenue and patient volume over the latest fiscal year. MMCSB remains a well-regarded brand for healthcare in the region and has been conferred the "Malaysia Medical Tourism Hospital of the Year 2015" award by Frost & Sullivan. In its 6th year of operations, RSHSB continues its fast growth and looks to further expand its range of specialist healthcare offerings, improve customer service and strengthen connections with the local community.

To cope with the growing number of patients at the Group's hospitals, both MMCSB and RSHSB have commenced their respective upgrading and expansion plans. This includes the addition of a day surgery unit, more inpatient beds and expansion of cancer program at MMCSB, as well as the proposed construction of a new 10-storey medical outpatient block at RSHSB.

In Malaysia, despite low commodity prices and political uncertainty leading to a weakening of the Malaysian Ringgit, a healthy rising trend in domestic insurance penetration, an aging population and increasing regional connectivity are still expected to further contribute to the growth of private healthcare services. However, the healthcare landscape in Malaysia will remain competitive with new hospitals being developed. The shortage of skilled manpower remains a challenge for all healthcare operators and may result in cost pressures due to wage inflation.

Barring unforeseen circumstances, the Directors are cautiously optimistic that the Group will continue to perform well in the next fiscal year.

On 7 May 2015, the Group made an announcement via SGXNet confirming that the Group has received non-binding expressions of interest for MMCSB. The Group continually explores and reviews its strategic options with respect to its healthcare business, including considerations relating to a potential sale of MMCSB. The Group has not made any definitive decision with respect to, and has not entered into any definitive agreement for, a potential sale of MMCSB. There is no assurance that any definitive agreement for the sale of MMCSB will be entered into.

#### **REVENUE BY SEGMENTS:**

Group revenue of RM 345.2 million was RM 52.3 million or 18% above that of the previous year. The increase was mainly driven by the increase in revenue from Hospital and other healthcare services segment, up RM 51.0 million from prior year, due to higher patient load and average bill sizes in its two hospitals.

#### **NET PROFIT BY SEGMENTS:**

Group net profit before income tax of RM 54.8 million was RM 8.6 million higher than that of the prior year. Profit before income tax of Hospital and other healthcare services segment increased by RM 10.7 million whereas profit before income tax of all other segments fell by RM 3.3 million, mainly due to RM 3.0 million of share based expenses recorded for the first time in FY2015.

#### **REVENUE BY GEOGRAPHICAL SEGMENTS:**

Revenue from Singapore was comparable to previous year. Higher revenue from Malaysia arose from Hospital and other healthcare services segment.
