Keppel donates \$300,000 to The Courage Fund in Singapore

Singapore, 14 February 2020 - Keppel Corporation Limited, through its philanthropic arm Keppel Care Foundation, will donate S\$300,000 to The Courage Fund to support communities in Singapore affected by the novel coronavirus disease, COVID-19.

The Courage Fund was established in 2003 to support victims of the Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome (SARS) and healthcare workers. As announced by the Singapore Government earlier this week, the Fund will now also be used to support those affected by COVID-19. These efforts will be facilitated and administered by the National Council of Social Service and Community Chest.
