Following the completion of the Share Consoliation, which became effective on 25 November 2015, the total number of issued shares of the Company (excluding treasury shares) was 204,578,897 after disregarding any fractions of a consolidated share arising from the Share Consolidation.

2013 Warrants

On 14 May 2014, the Company had allotted and issued the Warrants ("2013 Warrants") pursuant to the Warrants Issue. The 200,990,250 2013 Warrants were listed and quoted on the Official List of SGX-ST on 16 May 2014. The new shares arising from the exercise of the Warrants will be listed and quoted on the Official List of SGX-ST.

Further to the completion of the above Share Consolidation, the Company has made the following adjustments to the 2013 Warrants on the same date:

- a. on the basis that two (2) 2013 Warrants will be consolidated into one (1) Consolidated 2013 Warrant.
- b. the existing exercise price of each 2013 Consolidated Warrant will be adjusted from \$0.33 to \$0.66.
- c. each Consolidated 2013 Warrant shall carry the right to receive one (1) Consolidated Share.

Since 1 July 2018, no Consolidated 2013 Warrants were exercised to acquire new shares.

As of 31 December 2018, 97,396,852 (31 December 2017: 97,396,852) Consolidated 2013 Warrants are outstanding. If unexercised, the Consolidated 2013 Warrants will expire on 13 May 2019.

Review of Financial Results

Results for first half and second quarter ended 31 December 2018

Revenue

Revenue for 1H19 increased by \$0.3 million to \$49.2 million compared to \$48.9 million recorded in 1H18 due to increase in maintenance services revenue, partially offset by lower project services and contact centre services revenue.

Quarter-on-quarter, revenue decreased by \$1.9 million to \$22.5 million in 2Q19 due to lower project services and contact centre services revenue, partially offset by increase in maintenance services revenue.

Cost of sales

For 1H19, cost of sales increased by 20.6% to \$30.2 million mainly due to higher subcontractor costs incurred in 1Q19 and higher material costs incurred in 2Q19.

Quarter-on-quarter, cost of sales remained comparable at approximately \$13 million notwithstanding the decrease in revenue mainly due to higher material costs in 2Q19.

Other income

Other income comprise mainly of interest income, miscellaneous income earned from non-core businesses, safety and performance incentives, gain on disposal of property, plant and equipment as well as government grant, jobs credit grant and special employment credit. The amount of other income for 1H19 and 2Q19 was \$0.8 million and \$0.2 million respectively, comparable to 1H18 and 2Q18.

Operating expenses

Operating expenses consist of distribution and selling expenses, administrative expenses and other operating expenses, including depreciation, amortisation and exchange differences.

For 1H19, total operating expenses decreased by \$1.0 million from \$19.3 million in 1H18 to \$18.3 million in 1H19 mainly due to lower travelling and transportation related expenses.

For 2Q19, operating expenses remained comparable to 2Q18 at \$9.0 million.

Taxation

The effective tax rate in 1H19 was 17% which is comparable to the statutory tax rate.

Profit attributable to equity holders of the Company

The profit attributable to equity holders for 1H19 decreased by \$2.9 million to \$1.3 million compared to \$4.2 million in 1H18.

Quarter-on-quarter, the profit attributable to equity holders for 2Q19 decreased by \$1.3 million to \$0.7 million compared to \$2.0 million in 2Q18.

Review of Financial Position

Non-current assets

Non-current assets of the Group decreased from \$55.0 million as at 30 June 2018 to \$53.4 million as at 31 December 2018 due to depreciation of property, plant and equipment and classification of customer retention as a current asset.

Current assets

Current assets increased by \$2.1 million from \$92.9 million as at 30 June 2018 to \$95.0 million as at 31 December 2018. The increase is due to increase in contract assets, bank deposits pledged and customer retention, partially offset by decrease in cash and cash equivalents.

Current liabilities

Current liabilities comprise of payables to suppliers of materials and equipment and subcontractors, other payables, advances from customers, provision for warranty as well as tax provision.

Current liabilities decreased by \$0.9 million from \$25.8 million as at 30 June 2018 to \$24.9 million as at 31 December 2018, mainly due to decrease in trade and other payables, partially offset by increase in contract liabilities.

Non-current liabilities

Non-current liabilities decreased from \$1.8 million as at 30 June 2018 to \$1.6 million as at 31 December 2018 mainly due to classification of supplier retention as a current liability.

Utilisation of Warrant Issue Proceeds

2013 Warrants

On 16 May 2014, the Company had allotted and issued 200,990,250 2013 Warrants and raised net proceeds of \$13,000 for general working capital. The amount was applied in accordance with the announcement dated 9 May 2014.

From 16 May 2014 to 31 December 2018, 6,196,359 2013 Warrants were exercised for 6,196,359 new shares. The Company raised net proceeds of approximately \$2.0 million, which was used to acquire property, plant and equipment for business expansion.
