



## **OKP HOLDINGS LIMITED**

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# **PROPOSED BONUS ISSUE OF UP TO 231,322,945 NEW ORDINARY SHARES IN THE CAPITAL OF OKP HOLDINGS LIMITED (THE "COMPANY") ON THE BASIS OF THREE (3) BONUS SHARES FOR EVERY FOUR (4) EXISTING ORDINARY SHARES IN THE CAPITAL OF THE COMPANY**

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## **Introduction**

The board of directors (the "**Directors**") of the Company wishes to announce that the Company is proposing a bonus issue (the "**Proposed Bonus Issue**") of up to 231,322,945 new ordinary shares in the capital of the Company (the "**Bonus Shares**"), on the basis of three (3) Bonus Shares to be credited as fully paid for every four (4) existing issued ordinary shares in the capital of the Company (the "**Shares**"), held as at a time and date to be determined by the Directors in due course for the purpose of determining the entitlements of holders of Shares (the "**Record Date**"), fractional entitlements to be disregarded.

## **Terms of the Proposed Bonus Issue**

### Bonus Shares

As at the date of this announcement, the Company has an issued and paid-up share capital of 308,430,594 Shares (including treasury shares) and accordingly up to 231,322,945 Bonus Shares will be issued pursuant to the Proposed Bonus Issue (assuming there is no change in the number of issued Shares from the date of this announcement up to the Record Date). The actual number of Bonus Shares to be issued by the Company will depend on the total issued share capital of the Company (including treasury shares) as at the Record Date. Assuming that all 231,322,945 Bonus Shares are issued, the enlarged share capital of the Company will increase to 539,753,539 Shares (including treasury shares). As at the date of this announcement, the Company has 1,469,100 Shares held as treasury shares and the Company's subsidiary corporations do not hold any shares in the Company.

The Bonus Shares will be allotted and issued as fully paid at nil consideration without capitalisation of the Company's reserves. The Bonus Shares, when allotted and issued, will rank *pari passu* in all respects with the existing ordinary shares in the capital of the Company and with each other, except that the Bonus Shares will not be entitled to any dividends, rights, allotments or other distributions, the record date of which falls before the date on which the Bonus Shares are allotted and issued.

The Bonus Shares represent approximately 75% of the existing issued and paid-up share capital (including treasury shares) of the Company as at the date of this announcement and approximately 42.86% of the enlarged share capital (including treasury shares) of the Company following the completion of the Proposed Bonus Issue, assuming there are no changes to the total issued share capital of the Company as at the Record Date.

## Approvals

The Proposed Bonus Issue is subject to, *inter alia*:

- (a) the approval of the Singapore Exchange Securities Trading Limited ("**SGX-ST**") being obtained for the listing and quotation of the Bonus Shares on the Official List of the SGXST and compliance with such conditions (if any) as the SGX-ST may impose in connection therewith; and
- (b) shareholders' approval for the Proposed Bonus Issue being obtained by way of an ordinary resolution at an extraordinary general meeting of the Company ("**EGM**") to be convened.

The Company will make an application to the SGX-ST for the dealing in, listing of and quotation for the Bonus Shares on the Official List of the SGX-ST. The Company will make the necessary announcement upon receipt of the listing and quotation notice from the SGX-ST.

A circular containing, *inter alia*, information on the Proposed Bonus Issue and the notice of EGM will be despatched to Shareholders in due course.

## Compliance with Listing Manual

Pursuant to Rule 838 of the Listing Manual of the SGX-ST (the "**Listing Manual**"), an issuer must satisfy the SGX-ST that the daily weighted average price of its shares, adjusted for the bonus issue, will not be less than S\$0.50 ("**Minimum Price**"). In compliance with Rule 838, the issuer should compute the adjusted price based on the proposed bonus issue ratio and the issuer's lowest daily weighted share price of the shares for a month preceding the issuer's proposed bonus issue application.

For illustration purposes only and assuming that the Proposed Bonus Issue application has been made on 27 November 2025, being the date of this announcement, the lowest daily weighted average price of the Shares in the month preceding 27 November 2025 would be S\$0.9736 and accordingly, the theoretical ex-bonus price ("**TEBP**") would be calculated as follows:

$$\begin{aligned}TEBP &= \frac{S\$0.9736}{7} \times 4 \\ &= S\$0.5563\end{aligned}$$

Accordingly, the TEBP will be above the Minimum Price. Further, the Company confirms that there is no reason to believe that the TEBP is likely to fall below S\$0.50 for the month preceding the date of the application for the listing and quotation of the Bonus Shares on the Official List of the SGX-ST.

## Record Date

The Bonus Shares will be issued to the holders of Shares whose names appear in the Register of Members of the Company or the records of The Central Depository (Pte) Limited, as the case may be, as at the Record Date to be determined by the Directors for the purpose of determining entitlements under the Proposed Bonus Issue. Notice of the Record Date will be given at a later date, after the necessary approvals in respect of the Proposed Bonus Issue (including, without limitation, the approvals from the SGX-ST) have been obtained.

### **Rationale for the Proposed Bonus Issue**

The Company is considering the Proposed Bonus Issue to reward and give due recognition to shareholders for their loyalty and continuing support for the Company. The Proposed Bonus Issue, if carried out, will also increase the accessibility of investing in the Company to more investors, thereby encouraging trading liquidity and greater participation by investors and broadening the shareholder base of the Company.

### **Interests of Directors and Substantial Shareholders**

None of the Directors and substantial shareholders of the Company has any interest, direct or indirect, in the Proposed Bonus Issue other than through their respective shareholdings in the Company.

### **Responsibility Statement**

The Directors collectively and individually accept full responsibility for the accuracy of the information given in this announcement and confirm after making all reasonable enquiries that, to the best of their knowledge and belief, this announcement constitutes full and true disclosure of all material facts about the Proposed Bonus Issue, the Company and its subsidiaries, and the Directors are not aware of any facts the omission of which would make any statement in this announcement misleading.
