#### 1. Corporate information

Sinostar PEC Holdings Limited ("the Company") is incorporated and domiciled in Singapore as a limited liability company. The Company is listed on the Singapore Exchange Mainboard ("SGX-ST").

The immediate and ultimate holding company of the Company is Intelligent People Holdings Limited ("Intelligent People"), a company which is incorporated in the British Virgin Islands ("BVI").

The Company's registered office is located at 30 Cecil Street, #19-08 Prudential Tower, Singapore 049712.

The principal activity of the Company is that of an investment holding company. The principal activities of its subsidiary corporations are:

- (a) Manufacture and sale of propylene, polypropylene and LPG products;
- (b) Provide logistics and transportation related services for petroleum products; and
- (c) Manufacture and sale of propylene, purified isobutylene, methyl tert-butyl ether (commonly known as MTBE), hydrogen and mixed gas.

These condensed interim consolidated financial statements as at and for the three months ended 31 March 2024 comprise the Company and its subsidiaries (collectively, "the Group").

#### 2. Basis of Preparation

The condensed interim financial statements for the three months ended 31 March 2024 have been prepared in accordance with SFRS(I) 1-34 *Interim Financial Reporting* issued by the Accounting Standards Council Singapore. The condensed interim financial statements do not include all the information required for a complete set of financial statements. However, selected explanatory notes are included to explain events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the Group's financial position and performance of the Group since the last interim financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2023.

The accounting policies adopted are consistent with those of the previous financial year which were prepared in accordance with SFRS(I)s, except for the adoption of new and amended standards as set out in Note 2.1.

The condensed interim financial statements are presented in Chinese Renminbi dollar which is the functional currency of the Company and have been rounded to the nearest thousand ("RMB'000").

#### 2.1. New and amended standards adopted by the Group

A number of amendments to Standards have become applicable for the current reporting period. The Group did not have to change its accounting policies or make retrospective adjustments as a result of adopting those standards.

#### 2.2. Use of judgements and estimates

In preparing the condensed interim financial statements, management has made judgements, estimates and assumptions that affect the application of accounting policies and the reported amounts of assets and liabilities, income and expense. Actual results may differ from these estimates.

The significant judgements made by management in applying the Group's accounting policies and the key sources of estimation uncertainty were the same as those that applied to the consolidated financial statements as at and for the year ended 31 December 2023.

Estimates and underlying assumptions are reviewed on an ongoing basis. Revisions to accounting estimates are recognised in the period in which the estimates are revised and in any future periods affected.

Information about critical judgements in applying accounting policies that have the most significant effect on the amounts recognised in the financial statements are as following:

Useful lives of property, plant and equipment

The costs of property, plant and equipment are depreciated using the straight-line to allocate the depreciable amount over the estimated useful live. The useful lives of these assets are estimated by the management using common life expectancies applied in the industry and country of operations. Changes in the expected level of usage and technological developments could impact the economic useful lives of these assets, thus affecting the depreciation charges of property, plant and equipment.

Valuation of financial asset at fair value through other comprehensive income ("FVOCI")

The Group classified unquoted equity security as financial asset at FVOCI and recognises changes in its fair value in other comprehensive income. The fair value is determined based on estimates using present values. This is significantly affected by the assumptions used, including discount rate and estimate of future cash flows.

# 3. Seasonal operations

The Group's businesses are not affected significantly by seasonal or cyclical factors during the financial period.

# 4. Segment and revenue information

For management purposes, the Group is organised into business units based on their products and services, and has two reportable operating segments as follows:

- 1. The gas separation segment is the manufacturing and sales of LPG, propylene, polypropylene, MTBE, hydrogen, isobutylene and other gas.
- 2. The transport and logistic services segment are the provision of logistics and transportation related services for petroleum products.

Except as indicated above, no operating segments have been aggregated to form the above reportable operating segments.

The recoverable amount of a CGU was determined based on value-in-use. Cash flow projections used in the value-in-use calculations were based on financial budgets approved by management covering a five-year period. Cash flows beyond the five-year period were extrapolated using terminal growth rate of 3% (2023: 3%). These cash flows were discounted using a pre-tax discount rate of 10% (2023: 10%) that reflected current market assessment of the time value of money and the risks specific to the CGUs. The growth rate is based on past performance and expectations on market development.

Management determines that the recoverable amount is higher than the carrying amount. Accordingly, no impairment for allowance is provided. The Group believes that any reasonable possible changes on the above key assumptions are not likely to cause the recoverable amount to be materiality lower than the related carrying amount.

## (a) Processed LPG

LPG decreases by 5.32% from RM447.99 million in 1Q23 to RMB424.17 million in 1Q24, included the inter-company transactions. A total of 88,695 tonnes produced and sold during the periods, an increase of 14.70% as compared to 1Q23. Both average selling prices ("ASP") and average cost of production ("ACP") during the period decrease by 17.45% and 17.37% respectively as compared to 1Q23.

#### (b) **Propylene**

Propylene is used to further process into premium grade polypropylene in 1Q24.

## (c) Premium grade polypropylene

Premium grade polypropylene increases by 7.07% from RMB379.50 million in 1Q23 to RMB406.32 million in 1Q24, included the inter-company transactions. Total sales volume also increases by 10.84% from 55,178 tonnes in 1Q23 to 61,162 tonnes in 1Q24. ASP and ACP both decrease by 3.41% and 10.10% respectively as compared to 1Q23.

#### (d) Polypropylene

Due to the shutdown and overhaul of the 50,000-ton polypropylene unit, the Group did not record any product sales in 1Q23. It resumed production in 2Q23.

Therefore, in 1Q24, a total of 10,269 tons of polypropylene were sold, with a sales revenue of RMB 64.58 million.

#### (e) MTBE

Sale of MTBE increase by 18.56% from RMB508.58 million in 1Q23 to RMB602.96 million in 1Q24. Total sales volume increases 23.71% from 83,335 tonnes in 1Q23 to 103,090 tonnes in 1Q24. Both ASP and ACP during the period decrease by 4.16% and 16.08% respectively as compared to 1Q23

#### .

# (f) <u>Hydrogen</u>

In 1Q24, hydrogen sales volume increase by 33.16% to 4,516 tonnes as compared to 3,391 tonnes in 1Q23. Revenue has an increase of 32.63% from RMB49.93 million in 1Q23 to RMB66.22 million in 1Q24, included the inter-company transactions. ASP has decrease by 0.40% and ACP has increase by 10.88% as compared to 1Q23.

## (g) <u>Isobutylene</u>

Sale of isobutylene has increase 0.49% from RMB46.41 million in 1Q23 to RMB46.64 million in 1Q24 as total sales volume has increase by 1.52% to 5,058 tonnes as compared with 4,982 tonnes in 1Q23. Both ASP and ACP have decrease 1.02% and 26.50% respectively as compared to 1Q24.

#### (h) Other Gases

The sale of other gases has decrease by 7.54% from RMB8.94 million in 1Q23 to RMB8.26 million in 1Q24. However, total sales volume has increase 12.41% from 1,338 tonnes to 1,504 tonnes in 1Q24. Both ASP and ACP have decrease by 17.75% and 7.95% respectively.

#### (i) <u>Utilities</u>

Since 4Q23, the Group has changed its financial accounting method from the previous method of offsetting the cost of purchasing utilities to the current method of including in its sales revenue.

Therefore, revenue from this business has increase 100.00% to RMB35.39 million in 1Q24, included the inter-company transactions.

#### (j) Logistics & transport related service

Revenue from this business has increase 10.75% from RMB85.08 million in 1Q23 to RMB94.23 million in 1Q24, included the inter-company transactions.

#### **Gross profit**

Gross profit has increase from RMB40.96 million in 1Q23 to approximately RMB137.98 million in 1Q24. The increase in gross profit mainly comes from the following factors:-

In 1Q24, the sales volume of the gas separation business (including inter-company transactions) increased by 47,731.5 tons compared to the 1Q23. Gross profit margin of the company's main products, MTBE, isobutylene, and high-end polypropylene, has also increased compared 1Q23. Lastly, the sales volume of logistics and transportation business has increased compared to 1Q23.

#### Other income and expenses

#### (a) Other income

A total of RMB2.84 million has been received inclusive of RMB2.23 million of bank interest earned on short-term deposits placed with financial institution and other miscellaneous income of RMB0.61 million in 1Q24.

#### (b) Administrative costs

Administrative costs increase from RMB7.57 million in 1Q23 to RMB13.84 million in 1Q24, mainly due to the company's vigorous promotion of full-value chain optimization management and new product development. R&D expenses in 1Q24 increased by RMB8.68 million compared to the same period last year, which offset the decrease of RMB2.42 million in other administrative expenses.

#### (c) <u>Distribution costs</u>

Distribution costs increases from RMB0.07 million in 1Q23 to RMB2.30 million in 1Q24. This was mainly due to increase in providing of door-to-door transportation services to meet some customers' demand in 1Q24.

# (d) Finance costs

The finance costs have decreased from RMB9.76 million in 1Q23 to RMB6.56 million in 1Q24 as the amount of borrowings have decrease.

#### (e) <u>Taxation</u>

Quarterly tax provision is made by entities base on each profitability.

#### (f) Net Profit

The Group made a net profit of RMB88.37 million in 1Q24 as compared to RMB13.18 million in 1Q23. The increase in net profit is mainly due to the increase in gross profit.

#### **Condensed Interim Consolidated Statements of Financial Positions**

Highlights on changes in Condensed Interim Consolidated Statements of Financial Positions items of the Group are as follow; -

#### (a) Property, plant and equipment

The decrease is primarily attributed due to depreciation charge during the financial period.

#### (b) <u>Inventories</u>

Inventories comprise of approximately RMB154.65 million of raw materials, RMB5.45 million of semi-finished goods and equivalent value of RMB165.42 million on finished petrochemical products, recorded at cost.

#### (c) Prepayment

Increase is mainly due to amount paid to suppliers for raw materials and for equipment replacement.

#### (d) Non-controlling interest

Represent 30% controlling stake in subsidiary Dongming Qianhai by Dongming Petrochem Group.

#### (e) Bank Borrowings

This mainly consists of a bank loan to finance Dongming Hengchang's new polypropylene construction. The loan is guaranteed by the related party Dongming Zhongyou Fuel Petrochemical Co., Ltd. The interest is calculated at a floating rate and repayment is made every six months, and full settlement is scheduled to be completed by January 2027.

#### (f) Loan from non-controlling interests

This is from non-controlling interest Dongming Petrochem Group (represent 30% minority stake in subsidiary Dongming Qianhai) to finance the working capital use since the acquisition of Dongming Qianhai. Term of loan is unsecured, with an annual interest at 4.75% per annum, repayable in instalments on a quarterly basis till full settlement by 1 April 2025.

A total of RMB50.0 million has been repaid in 1Q24.

#### **Condensed Interim Consolidated Statement of Cash Flow**

The Group's operating activities resulted in a net cash inflow of RMB146.51 million and its investment activities also resulted in a net cash inflow of RMB1.26 million, while its financing activities resulted in a net cash outflow of RMB56.56 million during the first quarter of 2024. As of 31 March 2024, the group had a cash balance of RMB654.10 million.
