PRICING OF \$\$30,000,000 4.10% FIXED RATE NOTES DUE 2020 PURSUANT TO THE \$\$500,000,000 MULTICURRENCY MEDIUM TERM NOTE PROGRAMME

Cambridge Industrial Trust Management Limited, as Manager (the "Manager") of Cambridge Industrial Trust ("CIT"), wishes to announce that Cambridge-MTN Pte. Ltd. (the "Issuer"), a wholly owned subsidiary of RBC Investor Services Trust Services Singapore Limited (in its capacity as trustee of CIT) (the "CIT Trustee") has launched and priced S\$30,000,000 4.10% fixed rate notes due 2020 comprised in Series 002 (the "Series 002 Notes"). The Series 002 Notes will be issued pursuant to the S\$500,000,000 Multicurrency Medium Term Note Programme established by the Issuer on 2 February 2012 (the "Programme"). Australia and New Zealand Banking Group Limited has been appointed as the dealer of the Series 002 Notes.

The Series 002 Notes will bear an interest rate of 4.10% per annum payable semi-annually in arrear and have a tenor of six years.

The net proceeds arising from the issue of the Series 002 Notes under the MTN Programme (after deducting issue expenses) will be on-lent to the CIT Trustee for the purpose of (a) refinancing the existing borrowings of CIT, (b) financing or refinancing the acquisitions and/or investments of CIT and any development and asset enhancement works initiated by CIT and (c) financing general working capital and capital expenditure requirements of CIT.

Application will be made to the Singapore Exchange Securities Trading Limited (the "SGX-ST") for permission to deal in and quotation for the Series 002 Notes. The SGX-ST assumes no responsibility for the correctness of any of the statements made or opinions expressed or reports contained herein or in the information memorandum relating to the MTN Programme. Admission to the Official List of the SGX-ST and quotation of the Series 002 Notes on the SGX-ST is not to be taken as an indication of the merits of the Programme or the Series 002 Notes.

The Series 002 Notes are expected to be issued on 29 April 2014 and listed on the business day after the issue date.
