NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Annual General Meeting of Mencast Holdings Ltd. (the "Company") will be held at 42B Penjuru Road, Level 2 Auditorium, Singapore 609163 on Thursday, 25 April 2019 at 10.30 a.m. for the following purposes:

## AS ORDINARY BUSINESS

- To receive and adopt the Directors' Statement and the Audited Financial Statements of the Company for the financial year ended 31 December 2018 together with the 1. Auditors' Report thereon. (Resolution 1)
- 2. To re-elect the following Directors of the Company ("Directors") retiring pursuant to Article 89 of the Constitution of the Company:
  - (Resolution 2) (a) Mr Sunny Wong Fook Choy Note: Mr Sunny Wong Fook Choy shall, upon re-election as Director of the Company, remain as the Lead Independent Director, Chairman of the Nominating Committee and members of Remuneration and Audit Committees. He shall be considered independent for the purpose of Rule 704(8) of the Listing Manual of the Singapore Exchange Securities Trading Limited.
    - (Resolution 3)
  - (b) Mr Ho Chew Thim, Raymond Note: Mr Ho Chew Thim, Raymond shall, upon re-election as Director of the Company, remain as the Chairman of the Audit Committee and members of Nominating and Remuneration Committees. He shall be considered independent for the purpose of Rule 704(8) of the Listing Manual of the Singapore Exchange Securities Trading Limited.
  - To approve the payment of Directors' fees for the financial year ended 31 December 2018 comprising:
  - S\$90,368 to be paid in cash (previous year: S\$90,368). (a)
  - (b) S\$90,368 to be paid in shares (previous year: S\$90,368 paid in shares).
- To re-appoint Nexia TS Public Accounting Corporation as the Independent Auditor of the Company and to authorise the Directors to fix their remuneration. 4.
- 5 To transact any other ordinary business which may properly be transacted at an Annual General Meeting.

#### AS SPECIAL BUSINESS

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To consider and if thought fit, to pass the following resolutions as Ordinary Resolutions, with or without any modifications:

- Authority to issue shares in the capital of the Company ("Shares") 6.
  - That pursuant to Section 161 of the Companies Act, Cap. 50 and Rule 806 of the Listing Manual of the Singapore Exchange Securities Trading Limited ("SGX-ST"), the Directors of the Company be authorised and empowered to:
  - (a) (i) issue shares in the Company ("Shares") whether by way of rights, bonus or otherwise; and/or
    - make or grant offers, agreements or options (collectively, "Instruments") that might or would require shares to be issued, including but not limited to the (ii) creation and issue of (as well as adjustments to) options, warrants, debentures or other instruments convertible into shares, at any time and upon such terms and conditions and for such purposes and to such persons as the Directors of the Company may in their absolute discretion
  - deem fit; and (b) (notwithstanding the authority conferred by this Resolution may have ceased to be in force) issue shares in pursuance of any Instruments made or granted by the Directors of the Company while this Resolution was in force,
  - provided that
  - (1) the aggregate number of shares (including shares to be issued in pursuance of the Instruments, made or granted pursuant to this Resolution) to be issued pursuant to this Resolution shall not exceed fifty per centum (50%) of the total number of issued shares (excluding treasury shares and subsidiary holdings) in the capital of the Company (as calculated in accordance with sub-paragraph (2) below), of which the aggregate number of shares to be issued other than on a pro rata basis to shareholders of the Company shall not exceed twenty per centum (20%) of the total number of issued shares (excluding treasury shares and subsidiary holdings) in the capital of the Company (as calculated in accordance with sub-paragraph (2) below);
  - (subject to such calculation as may be prescribed by the SGX-ST) for the purpose of determining the aggregate number of shares that may be issued under (2)sub-paragraph (1) above, the total number of issued shares (excluding treasury shares and subsidiary holdings) shall be based on the total number of issued shares (excluding treasury shares and subsidiary holdings) in the capital of the Company at the time of the passing of this Resolution, after adjusting for: (a) new shares arising from the conversion or exercise of any convertible securities;
    - new shares arising from exercising share options or vesting of share awards which are outstanding or subsisting at the time of the passing of this Resolution; (b) and
    - any subsequent bonus issue, consolidation or subdivision of shares; (C)
  - (3) in exercising the authority conferred by this Resolution, the Company shall comply with the provisions of the Listing Manual of the SGX-ST for the time being in force (unless such compliance has been waived by the SGX-ST) and the Constitution of the Company; and
  - (4) unless revoked or varied by the Company in a general meeting, such authority shall continue in force until the conclusion of the next Annual General Meeting ("AGM") of the Company or the date by which the next AGM of the Company is required by law to be held, whichever is earlier. #### Authority to issue shares under the Mencast Performance Share Award Scheme 7.

That pursuant to Section 161 of the Companies Act, the Directors be and are hereby authorised to offer and grant awards ("Awards") in accordance with the provisions of the Mencast Performance Share Award Scheme (the "Scheme') and to allot and issue from time to time such number of fully-paid Shares as may be required to be issued pursuant to the vesting of the Awards under the Scheme, provided that the aggregate number of Shares to be allotted and issued pursuant to the Scheme, when added to the number of Shares issued and issuable in respect of all Awards, and all Shares issued and issuable in respect of all options granted or awards granted under any other share incentive schemes or share plans adopted by the Company and for the time being in force, shall not exceed fifteen per centum (15%) of the total issued Shares (excluding treasury shares and subsidiary holdings) from time to time and that such authority shall, unless revoked or varied by the Company in a general meeting, continue in force until the conclusion of the next AGM or the date by which the next AGM is required by law to be held, whichever is earlier. ### Explanatory Notes:

- The Ordinary Resolution 6, if passed, will empower the Directors of the Company, effective until the conclusion of the next Annual General Meeting of the Company, or İ. the date by which the next Annual General Meeting of the Company is required by law to be held or such authority is varied or revoked by the Company in a general meeting, whichever is the earlier, to issue shares, make or grant Instruments convertible into shares and to issue shares pursuant to such Instruments, up to a number not exceeding, in total, 50% of the total number of issued shares (excluding treasury shares and subsidiary holdings) in the capital of the Company, of which up to 20% may be issued other than on a pro-rata basis to shareholders.
- The Ordinary Resolution 7, if passed, will empower the Directors to offer and grant Awards under the Scheme in accordance with the provisions of the Scheme and ii. to issue from time to time such number of fully paid Shares as may be required to be issued pursuant to the vesting of the Awards subject to the maximum number of Shares prescribed under the terms and conditions of the Scheme. The aggregate number of Shares which may be issued pursuant to the Scheme and any other share-based schemes (if applicable) shall not exceed in aggregate (for the entire duration of the Scheme) fifteen per centum (15%) of the total number of issued Shares (excluding treasury shares and subsidiary holdings) from time to time.

#### Notes:

- 1. (a) A member, who is not a relevant intermediary, is entitled to appoint one or two proxies to attend and vote at the Annual General Meeting (the "Meeting") A member, who is a relevant intermediary, is entitled to appoint more than two proxies to attend and vote at the Meeting, but each proxy must be appointed to (b) exercise the rights attached to a different Share or Shares held by such member.
- "Relevant intermediary" has the meaning ascribed to it in Section 181 of the Companies Act, Cap. 50.
- 2. A proxy need not be a member of the Company.
- 3 The instrument appointing a proxy must be deposited at the Registered Office of the Company at 42E Penjuru Road, Mencast Central, Singapore 609161 not less than forty-eight (48) hours before the time appointed for holding the Meeting.

#### Personal data privacy:

By submitting an instrument appointing a proxy(ies) and/or representative(s) to attend, speak and vote at the AGM and/or any adjournment thereof, a member of the Company (i) consents to the collection, use and disclosure of the member's personal data by the Company (or its agents) for the purpose of the processing and administration by the Company (or its agents) of proxies and representatives appointed for the AGM (including any adjournment thereof) and the preparation and compilation of the attendance lists, minutes and other documents relating to the AGM (including any adjournment thereof), and in order for the Company (or its agents) to comply with any applicable laws, listing rules, regulations and/or guidelines (collectively, the "Purposes"), (ii) warrants that where the member discloses the personal data of the member's proxy(ies) and/or representative(s) to the Company (or its agents), the member has obtained the prior consent of such proxy(ies) and/or representative(s) for the collection, use and disclosure by the Company (or its agents) of the personal data of such proxylies) and/or representative(s) for the Purposes, and (iii) agrees that the member will indemnify the Company in respect of any penalties, liabilities, claims, demands, losses and damages as a result of the member's breach of warranty
